GRACE MARKS (U.G./P.G.)

VI U. (2015 Admn.)/ IV P.G.(2016 admn.) Students who are eligible for grace marks are hereby informed to apply for the same by 24 November, 2017. The photocopies of the certificates duly attested by the faculty of Dept. of Physical Education / Fine Arts adviser/NCC teacher in charge/ NSS teacher in charge and the Principal, need be submitted to the CE's Office. The criteria for the eligibility are the following:

SPORTS AND GAMES

1. Inter-collegiate performance in sports and games: I and II places.
2. Inter University participation / member of university team and represented in tournaments.
3. Inter university: South Zone semi-finalists / winners, qualifying for the All India Inter University.
4. All India Inter University- I, II, III or IV place winners in individual events, team events or relays.
5. Establishing new Inter University Record.
6. Representing Kerala State in Junior/ Senior National.
7. Winning national juniors – I, II or III places.
8. Winning national seniors – I, II or III places.
9. Representing Indian Universities – Seniors / Juniors.
10. Representing India in International Competitions: Juniors/ Seniors / Indian Universities and winning I, II or III place.

1. Inter-zone I Place Individual / Group.
2. South Zone Inter University Youth Festival conducted by the Association of Indian Universities – Individual or Group (winning and participation)
