MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

THE INSTITUTE OF MATERIALS FOR ELECTRONICS AND MAGNETISM (IMEM) OF THE NATIONAL RESEARCH COUNCIL (CNR), PARMA, ITALY

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is entered between the Institute of Materials for Electronics and Magnetism (IMEM) and Coordinator of a Smart Energy Program, and the Department of Physics, St. Thomas 'College, Thrissur, on the day of August 31st, 2022.

St. Thomas 'College, Thrissur, an Autonomous Institution awarded with Potential for Excellence possesses 63rd Position in NIRF ranking in India 2022 and the college has shown continuous improvement in the field of higher education and research in the state of Kerala. St. Thomas' College (Autonomous) Thrissur is the oldest Catholic College in Kerala with around 100 years' tradition of social commitment in helping local community. The college has 28 leaching departments which offer 14 PG programmes and 28 UG programmes. The college also has 10 research centres where more than hundred research scholars are engaging in quality research.

The Department of Physics, St. Thomas' College (Autonomous) Thrissur, was established in the year 1922. The department was elevated as a recognised research centre in 2016 under the University of Calicut.
