

Quality Initiatives by IQAC

Preparation of Academic Calendar

IQAC ensured timely preparation and release of college academic calendar for the year 2021-2022. Inputs and scheduling of various events were collected from Governing council, academic council, office of the Controller of Examinations, college council, principal, departments, cells and clubs. Dr. Thomas M.T., assistant professor, meticulously organized the preparation of calendar by streamlining the data collected from various stakeholders under the guidance of principal and IQAC. Academic Calendar took into consideration the curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in the College and the proposed examination schedules.

Participation in NIRF Ranking 2022

In the light of previous years' experience, it was decided to optimize the participation in NIRF Ranking in such a way that a better rank could be obtained. Data was collected from the online tool EXaT, the online documentation system of the college. Institutional, departmental, faculty and student Data of 2020-2021 was enhanced exhaustively with the support of SQAC, DQAC and IQAC core team members. Data was streamlined and processed as per the proforma. Data was submitted after the due approval from the staff council and college council.

College Newsletters

The eighth volume of Chronicle, the official college newsletter, was released in November 2020. Dr. Syam Sukhakar is the Editor of the volume. The initiative was supervised by Dr. CS Biju and Dr. Anil George K, IQAC Coordinator.

Besides, the online Daily Newsletter is being released every day through the college website, edited and published by Dr. Anu Paul, Assistant Professor, supported by the SQAC members.

Green, Energy and Environment Audit

In pursuit of the commitment of the college towards green initiatives, IQAC initiated Green, Energy and Water Audits with the support of authorized external auditing agency during the academic year. The audit was jointly conducted by Integrated Rural Technology Centre (IRTC), a core granted supported institution of DST, Government of India and OTTOTRACTIONS, Thiruvananthapuram, an accredited energy auditor from Kerala. Workshop for Parents



Awareness Seminar on Social Equity

An awareness seminar on atrocities against women and children was organized on 28 October 2021 by Internal Complaints Committee and Department of Social Work at the recommendation of IQAC.

e-Governance Initiatives

Admission was conducted completed online including personal interactions with the candidates and parents and payment of fees. Student Induction Programme was conducted online. Class PTAs, General PTA and Global Alumni Meets were organized online with the support of appropriate softwares. The ERP was updated with the newly recruited faculty, students and staff. Almost all seminars, conferences and training programmes were conducted online in the context of Covid.



Teaching-Learning Process was conducted in online mode with the support of Moodle online platform. Faculties created video lectures and posted it on the college YouTube channel for the benefit of the student fraternity at large. Feedbacking mechanism was done in online mode. Interactive Panels were installed at various seminar halls to facilitate online teaching-learning process. In order to implement Question Bank system under OBE paradigm, QnSmarti was employed under the office of Controller of Examinations.

Financial Support to organize Events

IQAC supported academic departments, clubs and cells with financial incentives to organize events that would improve quality at various levels. Academic departments are supported to organize seminars, conferences, workshops and training programmes. Clubs and Cells are financially supported to organize skill development programmes.

Self-Appraisal of Faculty and PBAS

IQAC initiated collection of Self-Appraisal of Faculty to be submitted to the manager for evaluation and enhancement of the faculty. Additionally, the Performance Based Appraisal System of the faculty for promotion scrutinized by IQAC and sent to the affiliating university.

SWOC Analysis and NAAC Report Analysis



the NAAC Peer Team Report of 3rd Cycle was analyzed to take corrective measures. Infrastructural requirements were submitted to the management. Academic requirements were submitted to the principal.

Feedback Mechanism

Feedback on Curriculum

Feedback on syllabus by the students, faculty, alumni and employers was collected which was given to the department of Statistics for analysis. The analysis reports were given to the academic Deans to be communicated to the respective Boards of Studies for further consideration.

The analysis report was posted on the college website. Discussions regarding the recommendations and suggestions put forth by the stakeholders were taken up in the respective department councils and Boards of Studies based on the instructions given by IQAC. The proposed changes regarding the curriculum were discussed and ratified by the Board of studies and Academic Council. The summary and action taken report of the same was posted on the college website.

Feedback on Teachers and Teaching

Feedback on teachers and teaching-learning process in the college was taken from students in online mode through college ERP. The input of the feedback was automatically processed by the online tool. The analysis of the feedback was evaluated and made available to the respective teachers for further improvement in the teaching learning process. Principal took corrective and enhancive measures with the individual teachers wherever necessary.

Exit Survey from Outgoing Students

In view of bettering the academics, infrastructure, services and co-curricular ambience in the institution, an Exit survey was conducted among the out-going students. The survey consisted of two sections; the first enquires about the achievement of student learning outcomes and the second asks about satisfaction with various aspects and services of the college.


Survey on Online Teaching-Learning Process

Faculty Development Programmes

Faculty Orientation Programme

IQAC organized a faculty orientation programme entitled 'Responsible Citizens and Inspiring Teachers; A Professional Development Programme', on 01 June 2021. Justice Kurian Joseph (Retd), Judge, Supreme Court of India, was the resource person. Mar Tony Neelankavil, the manager, delivered the welcome address. Fr. Biju Panengadan, the

executive manager, addressed the faculty. Dr. Martin KA, delivered the presidential address, followed by the resourceful session by the chief guest. Dr. Alphonsa Mathew, vice principal proposed vote of thanks.



Research, Consultancy and Start-up: How to go about it?

The research council, IQAC and Innovation Cell jointly organised a webinar and training session entitled 'Research, Consultancy and Startup: How to go about it?' at 11.30 am on 16th June 2021 for the faculty and research scholars of our college.

Dr. Joseph Kuruvilla, principal scientist, Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology, was the resource person for the event. Dr. Martin KA, Principal, presided over the inaugural session.

Online Teaching-Learning: Training Programme

IQAC in collaboration the technical team of the college organized a one-week long handson training for the faculty of St. Thomas College, Thrissur, on advanced features available in MOODLE to make teaching learning process more efficient, interactive and fruitful. The training was scheduled from 12-16 July 2021. Certificates were issued by IQAC to the participants on successful completion of the training. Dr. Johns Naduvath, Ms. Rameela Ravindran and Mr. Ashbin Mathew handled the sessions.

In addition, Kerala State Higher Education Council, Government of Kerala, recruited Dr. Johns Naduvath, Department of Physics, as an expert resource person to train the faculty across Kerala in Moodle.

Online/Face-to-Face Faculty Development Programmes

Faculty members of the college attended several orientations programmes, refresher programmes, training programmes, short term programmes and other faculty development programmes organized by HRDCs, online platforms, Teaching-Learning centres recognized by UGC in online/offline mode. A total of 103 teachers attended such faculty development programmes during the academic year.

Webinar for the Non-Teaching Staff

An online awareness workshop on Code of Conduct was organized on 17 August 2021 for the administrative and laboratory staff. The session was handled by Dr. Alphonsa Mathew, Vice Principal and Dr. Martin KA, Principal. The event was organized by IQAC and was coordinated by Mr. Anto PJ and Mr. Sanjo Jose.

An Administrative Training Programme was organized for the non-teaching staff on 'Handson Workshop in Front Office' on 20 November 2021, in collaboration with NIMIT, Koratty.

Accreditation Initiatives

NAAC Data External Evaluation

External review of data to be submitted for the forthcoming 4th Cycle Accreditation was organized on 10 September 2021. Dr. Sudheer, PVC, Kerala Open University, was the external expert for the exercise. A total of 30 members closely working with the IQAC participated in the workshop. Dr. Martin KA, Principal, Fr. Biju Panengadan, Executive Manager, Dr. Alphonsa Mathew, Vice-Principal, IQAC Coordinator, Criteria Coordinators, and criteria team members were present during the event. Dr. Sudheer delivered the orientation talk for one hour, followed by the evaluation of data prepared. Dr. Saju MI, NAAC Coordinator, proposed vote of thanks.


IQAC-Department Interface Meetings

IQAC organized meetings with each department as part of preparation for forthcoming 4th Cycle NAAC Accreditation during the academic year. A team comprising of IQAC Coordinator, criteria coordinators and senior faculty members visited departments in teams and assessed faculty diary, mentor-mentee register and other documents. IQAC office verified the online departmental documentation and documentation by the faculty.

Mentee College Accredited

IQAC of St. Thomas College (Autonomous), Thrissur, mentored six colleges under UGC Paramarsh Scheme. The mentee colleges are going through various stages of accreditation process. Jubilee College of Nursing, Thrissur, and Amala College of Nursing and Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology (SIMAT), Vavannoor submitted Self Study

Report. And peer team visit held SIMAT, Vavannoor and the college was accredited with B++ Grade with Grade Point 2.94. SIMAT is the first mentee college that was accredited through the constant mentoring of St. Thomas College, Thrissur.



Student Enrichment Programmes

Student Orientation Programme

Student Orientation Programmes were organized online in the first week of June 2021 for all second year and third year students. Orientation for second- and third-year Undergraduate students was organized on 2 June 2021. Orientation and career guidance session was provided to the final year postgraduate students on 3 June 2021. Dr. Prashanth CMI, former Principal, SH College, Thevara, was the resource person for both the events.

Value-added Courses

St. Thomas College, Thrissur, introduced number of value-added courses for the skill development and employability of students. All first-year undergraduate students were expected to subscribe to at least one value-added course during the academic year. Courses were organized in blended mode. Dr. Sr. Alphonsa Mathew, vice principal, was the

coordinator of the value-added courses. Certificates were issued to students who successfully completed the courses.

Student Induction Programme

Student Induction Programme was organized for the first-year undergraduate students for one week from 4 to 8 October 2021. Mar Tony Neelankavil, the Manager, inaugurated and addressed the students and parents online. Dr. Martin KA, Principal, delivered the presidential address. Dr. Anil George K, IQAC Coordinator, handled a session on Vision, Mission and Code of Conduct. The student induction programme lasted for 5 days. Various sessions were handled to introduce the college and the student support systems. At the end of the programme, a baseline test was conducted to identify the slow learners and advanced learners so that they can be appropriately mentored

Research and Innovation

Research Awards to Faculty

It was decided to grant Research Awards to distinguished researchers in the college. Research Council in collaboration with IQAC set benchmarks and criteria to identify the deserving faculty and research scholars who excelled in research. Dr. Alphonsa Mathew, assistant professor and research guide, was awarded the lifetime best researcher award. Awards were also distributed at the department level for research scholars and faculty who excelled in research.

Seed Money for Research

IQAC recommended research promotion initiatives. Important among them was availing of seed money to the budding researchers. More than 20 faculty were provided with Rs. 25,000/- each as a support the research work under the condition that specific research outcomes are to be showcased including publication of at least one research paper in indexed journals.

Innovation Ambassadors

Faculty of the college underwent Innovation Ambassador training conducted by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and AICTE for one month duration. Four of the faculty qualified Innovation Ambassador at foundational level and two of them qualified Advanced Level.



Patents


Mr. Joby Sebastian, Department of Physics, made new patent file application for new innovative research finding. The research work is a collaborative work among researchers from 5 different institutions.
