
ANALYSIS REPORT-FEEDBACK ON ONLINE TEACHING 2021

The teaching learning process had a paradigm shift from classroom strategy to online mode due to the pandemic which resulted in nation-wide lockdown. The online classes were conducted through various LMS platforms like Moodle and Google classroom. Live sessions (through Google Meet, Microsoft Teams, Zoom etc.) and activities like assignments, seminars and quizzes were conducted through online mode. In order to understand the effectiveness of the adopted methodology, feedback were collected from students, faculty and parents.


#### **FEEDBACK - STUDENTS**


Do you have high-speed internet at home?




What device do you use for online teaching?




How would you describe your IT skills?




Have you ever participated in any type of e-learning before the pardemic




## What are the advantages of e-learning?




Rate the effectiveness of e-learning in terms of increasing knowledge (where 5-extremely effective, 1-extremely ineffective).




Rate your traditional classroom face-to-face learning (where 5- extremely active, 1-extremely inactive).







Rate how much did you enjoy e-learning classes during the pandemic (where 5-extremely enjoyable, 1-extremely unenjoyable).

#### Conclusions


- Only 41.8% students have high speed internet at home
- 94.5% students use smart phone for their classes
- Majority of students rate their IT skills as moderate (80.4%)
- Around 49.5% students rated moderate about the effectiveness of e-learning

- Around 54% students rated extremely active for traditional classroom learning
- 30.9% students rated moderate about the enjoyability of online classes
- Around 33.1% students rated moderate about the stress of online learning
- Around 44.1% students opined that learning is ok in online mode.




Do you have high speed internet at home?




What device do you use for online teaching?



The platform and software that you are using for online teaching?




How helpful the college has been in equipping you to teach online? (Consider 5 being extremely helpful and 1 being not at all)







How effective was the training on MOODLE and other online teaching tools? (Consider 5 being extremely effective and 1 being not at all)




How stressful do you find teaching remotely during the COVID-19 pandemic? (Consider 5 being extremely stressful and 1 being not at all)



How well could you maintain a work-life balance while teaching remotely? (Consider 5 being extremely well and 1 being not at all)




Preferred mode of education after pandemic.

#### Conclusions


- Around 80.6% faculty have high speed internet at home
- 83.3% faculty use laptop for their online classes
- 97.2% use Google meet as their platform for online teaching
- Around 40.3% faculty opined that the college has been very helpful in equipping teachers for e-learning
- Around 53.5% faculty opined that the training on Moodle was extremely effective
- Around 40.8% faculty rated moderate about the stress of online learning
- 38% opined that they could maintain work-life balance while online teaching extremely well.
- Around 61.1% faculty preferred blended learning after pandemic
- Around 50.7% faculty opined that learning is ok in online mode.




