

Application Procedure and Eligibility:

- Applications for admission can be submitted online through the college website at www.stthomas.ac.in
- Admission is based on the marks in the qualifying examination and entrance examination.
- Syllabus for the entrance examination and the mode of examination will be announced soon in the college website.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST, OBC and OEC communities shall be given relaxation as per the university rules.
- Eligibility:-
- MSc Computer Science: The candidate should have secured at least 55% of marks or equivalent grade in BSc. Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Physics or Mathematics or Statistics or Chemistry or BCA or BTech/BE (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Electronics and Telecommunication or Electronics and Communication) of University of Calicut or equivalent degree.
- Master of Social Work: Bachelor's Degree in any discipline recognised by the University of Calicut with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks/grade. Aggregate marks/grade means the total marks/grade obtained for Part I English and Part III (Core & Complementary). For those disciplines, which do not have English, only marks/grade of main and subsidiary will be taken into consideration.
- MA English: BA English Language & Literature/BA English & History/BA Functional English with at least 45% marks for English Main courses or BA/BSc (excluding alternative pattern) degree with at least 45% marks in Part I English, (Under Grade System: Overall CGPA, at least equivalent to 50%) of University of Calicut or equivalent degree.
- MA Visual Communication: Any student who has passed any degree of the University of Calicut or that of any other university or Institute recognised by the UGC or AICTE and ratified by the University of Calicut as equivalent there to with not less than an aggregate minimum of 45% marks or with an equivalent grade point under the regular stream (or in the distance stream) is eligible for admission.
