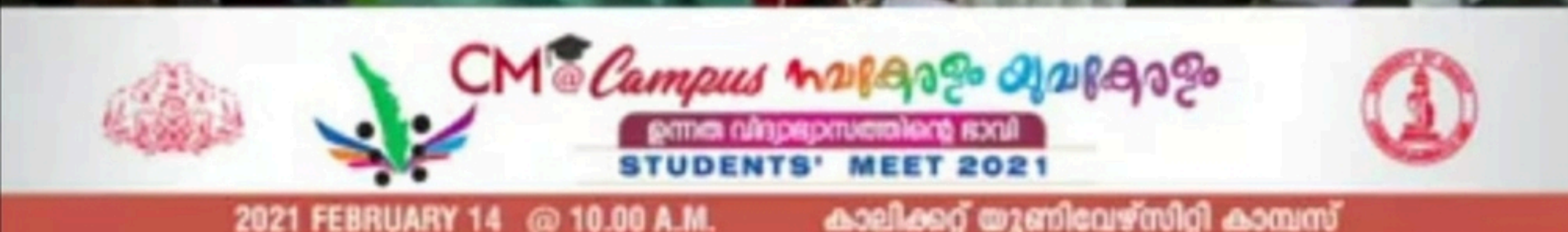

Mar Tony Neelankavil, the Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Thrissur, is currently the Manager of St. Thomas College. He was a Pre-Degree Science group student from 1 June, 1982 to 31 March, 1984.

Born on 23 July, 1967 to Chev. Prof. N. A. Ouseph, former Professor of English Department, St. Thomas College and T. J. Mary, teacher, Government Model High School for Girls, Thrissur. He joined St. Mary's Minor Seminary, Thrissur after Pre-degree studies and was ordained priest on 27 December, 1993. In 1995 he went to Catholic University, Leuven, Belgium to pursue his Masters and Doctoral Studies and defended his Dissertation in 2002 on *Towards an Intercultural Hermeneutics of Trinitarian Harmony: A Conversation Between Vedantic and Early Christian Traditions in Response to the Asian Synod*.

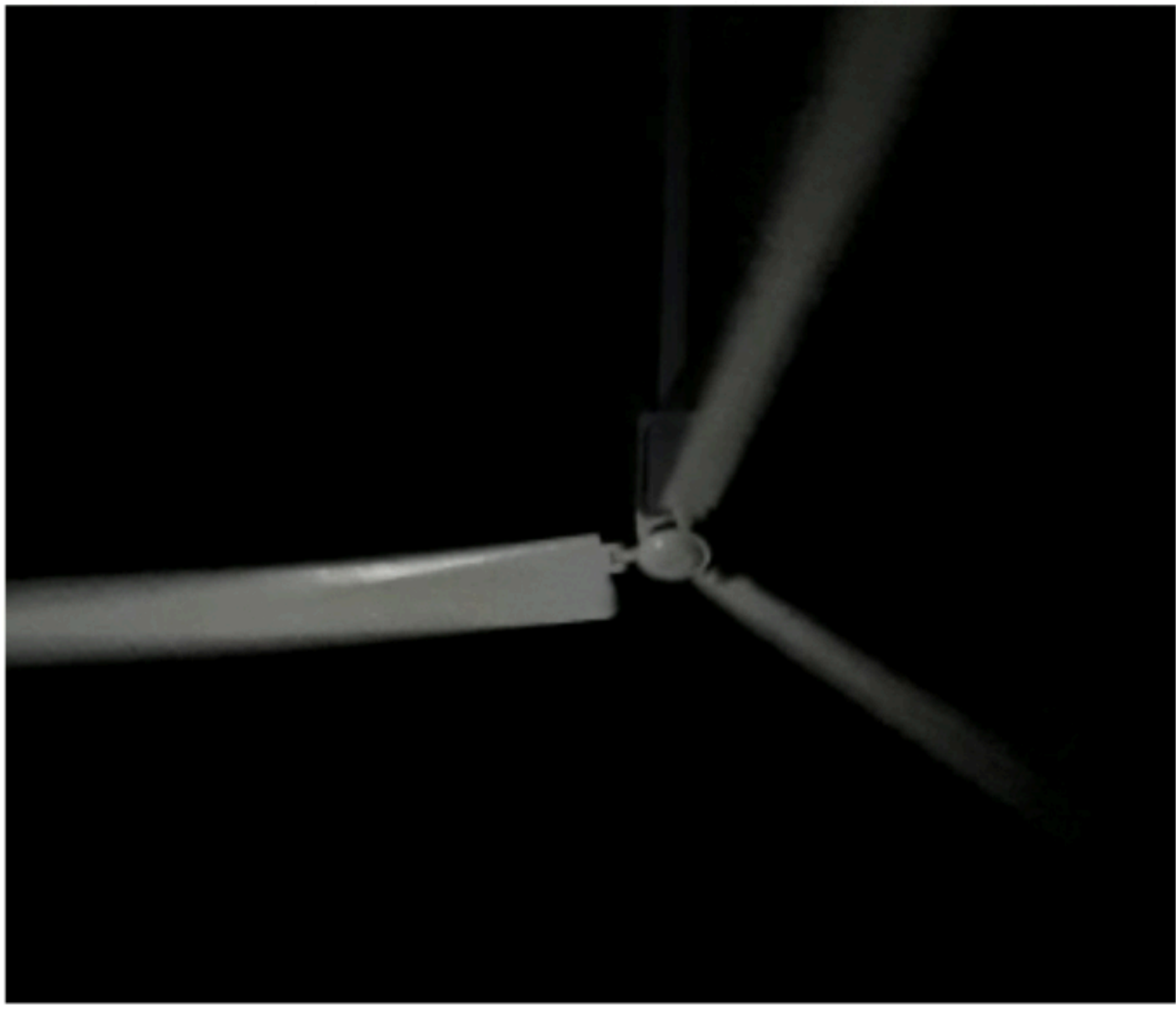
He has received research fellowship from the Catholic University, Leuven and he is Gambrinus Fellow of the Technische Universität, Dortmund, Germany. He has served the Marymatha Major Seminary, Thrissur from 2002 on as Professor, Dean and finally, as its Rector.

He was ordained Bishop on 18 November, 2017. Currently, he is the Chairman of the Doctrinal Commission of the KCBC as well as the Syro-Malabar Synod of Bishops. He is also the Chairman of two Research Institutes: the PAROC Research Institute, Thrissur and the Liturgical Research Institute, Kakkannad.
