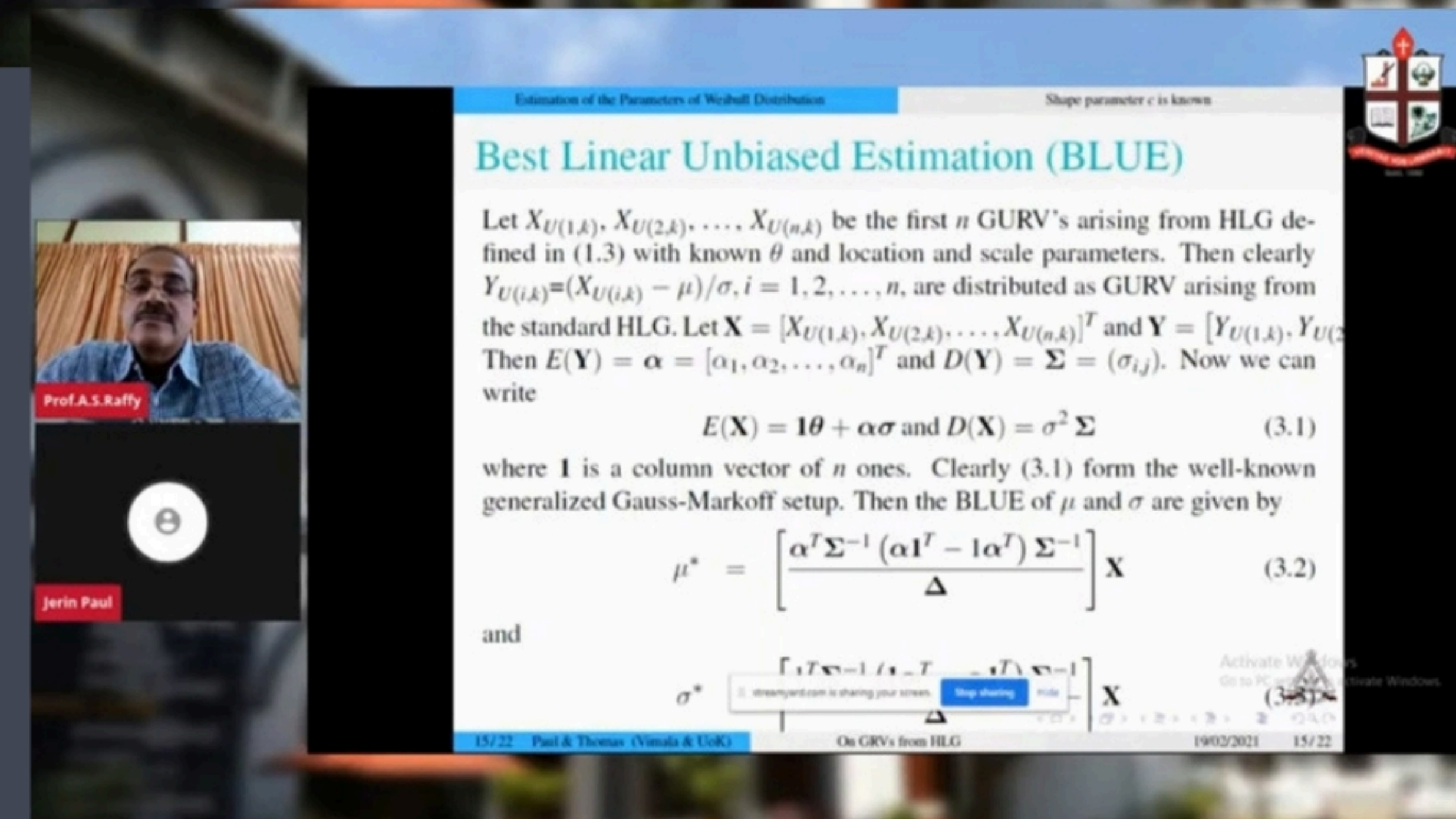

MSGR. PAUL KAKKASSERY

Msgr. Paul Kakkassery Ph.D., D.D., born on the Christmas day of 1900 as the son of Mattam Kakkassery Ouseph and Mariamma. After completing his studies at St. Thomas College, he joined in Candy Seminary for his priestly formation.

He was ordained on 5th October, 1930. He worked for 12 years as the editor of diocesan bulletin 'Nava Jeevika' from its starting in 1933. He was the parish priest of *Ollur Forane Church from 10 January, 1942 to 15 April, 1955. During this time, he was honored with the title of Monsignor by the Pope.

He planned and initiated many programmes for the poor people and even now those organisations are functioning well. 'Sadhu Samrakshana Sangham' (1943), Arora Club, Vincent De Paul Dispensary are doing good things still now. He was appointed as the rector of Thope Seminary and from 1958 he started his mission at Ootty. He was a great personality with kind heart.
