



## JUSTICE ASHOK MENON

Ashok Menon graduated from St. Thomas College, Thrissur and obtained Law Degree from Government Law College, Kozhikode. Ashok started practicing as a lawyer in Thrissur and Wadakkancherry Courts in 1981. He started serving as Munsiff-Magistrate in 1988. Thereafter promoted as Sub Judge in 1995 and as District Judge in 2002. He was appointed as Registrar, Supreme Court of India in 2009-10 and continued to be as Registrar, Competition Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi from 2010 to 2013. Thereafter served as Principal District Judge, Kollam from 2013 to 2015. In 2017, he was elevated as an Additional Judge of High Court of Kerala and became permanent judge of High Court of Kerala in 2019.

## JUSTICE M.S. RAMAN

Justice M.S. Raman also former student of St Thomas College, Thrissur. He was the judge of High Court of Kerala for 10 years. He was graduated in Law from Govt. Law College, Emakulam. He has served as Member of Kerala High Court Advocates Association and also advocate of various Government companies. He was elevated to the post of High Court Judge of Kerala in 2001 and retired from High Court in 2010.
