

## **ARCHBISHOP MAR ANDREWS** THAZHATH

He was born on 13 December, 1951 to Thazhath Anthappai and Rosa at Puthukkad. He joined the seminary on 14 June, 1967 and ordained on 14 March, 1977. Later he took his doctorate in Canon Law from Pontifical Oriental Institute of Rome.

He did his great service as KCBC President, Secretary, CBCI Vice President, Chancellor of Alwaye Pontifical institute, KCBC Education Commission Chairman, President of Oriental Canon Law Society of India and Judge of Syro Malabar Tribunal (Court).

He is the pioneer of Buon Natale, a cultural event for charity which has the Guinness record for participating most number of Santa Clauses across the globe and many other social service schemes and projects.

He worked hard and succeeded in attaining the autonomous status for the college and cleansing the college from political strikes. The college is planning to extend its new campus to Ramavarmapuram in his guidance as a memorial of it's centinary celebrations.
