PARLIAMENT OPPOSITION LEADER & UNION MINISTER

C.M STEPHEN

C. M Stephen, an Indian Parliamentarian, Union Minister and a congress leader who was the first opposition leader in Lok Sabha. He was the student of St Thomas College for Intermediate course. He was the opposition leader during the rule of Moraji Desai's Janatha Sarkar. He was an eloquent speaker and a leader of trade unions. Also he worked as AICC General Secretary and as a lawyer in Kollam. He was the President of Kollam District Congress Committee.

He was elected to Legislative assembly in 1960 and 1965. Moreover he was elected to Lok Sabha in 1971, 1977 and 1980.

C. M Stephen was born on 23 December 1918 to Eapen Mathai and Esther of Chembakassery house in Cherukole, Mavelikkara. He died on 16 January, 1984.
