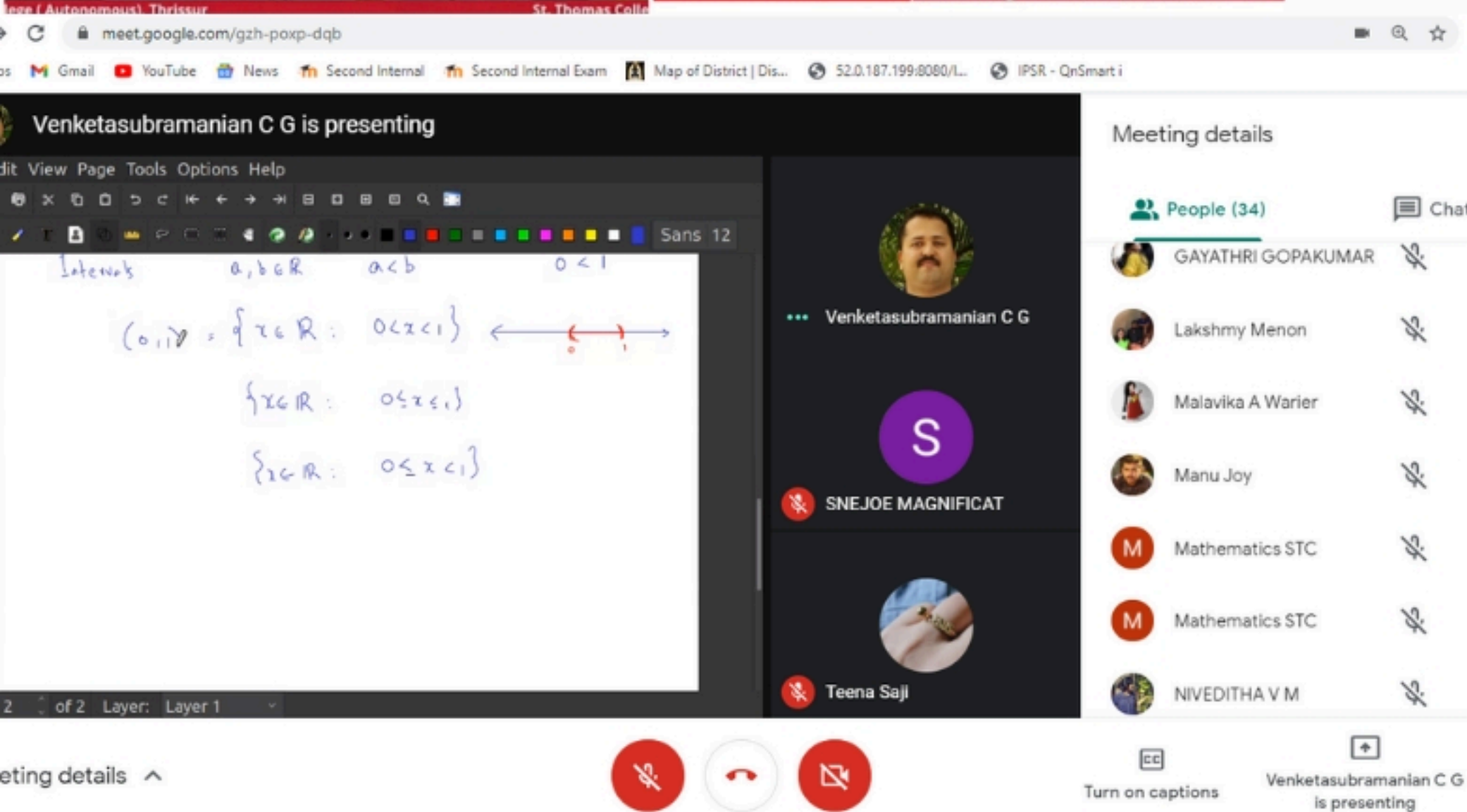

sumption expenditure in the third quarter too. The lost jobs in these sectors are not going to be restored automatically. The government is expecting that a new investment cycle will start soon. But it is unlikely in the presence of significant excess capacity in many sectors.

Policy certainty is a significant determinant for sustained recovery of the economy. The Union budget 2021-22 is growth-promoting with an adequate emphasis on capital formation. In India, there is a fundamental rethinking about the efficacy of "fiscal rules" — whether adhering to numeric threshold ratios of deficit is growth-enhancing or not. The finance minister has announced a high fiscal deficit of 9.5 per cent of gross domestic product in revised esti-

He was elected 3 times from Pudukkad constituency in 2006, 2011 and 2016 to Kerala Assembly and is the Education Minister since 2016. He was an active member of Complete Literacy Movement, AKPCTA and Sasthra Sahitya Parishad.

He has published books like "Nava Liberal" or "Durithangalude Nayam", "ASEAN Kararinte Yatharthyangal" and "Niyamasabha Prasangangal." To improve the standards of students who are suffering due to social-economic-emotional problems, he introduced "Sraddha Padhathi". He has also worked as an Advisor of State Planning Board and as a Convenor of Civil Planning Programme of Thrissur.
