





# Loosen the purse strings

With limitations of monetary policy, a fiscal push is crucial for sustained growth recovery

THAT THE INDIAN economy has managed to exit a "technical recession" to grow at 0.4 sumption expenditure in the third quarter too. The lost jobs in these sectors are not going to be restored automatically. The government is expecting that a new investment cycle will start soon. But it is unlikely in the presence of significant excess capacity in many sectors.

Policy certainty is a significant determinant for sustained recovery of the economy. The Union budget 2021-22 is growth-promoting with an adequate emphasis on capital formation. In India, there is a fundamental rethinking about the efficacy of "fiscal rules" — whether adhering to numeric threshold ratios of deficit is growth-enhancing or not.
