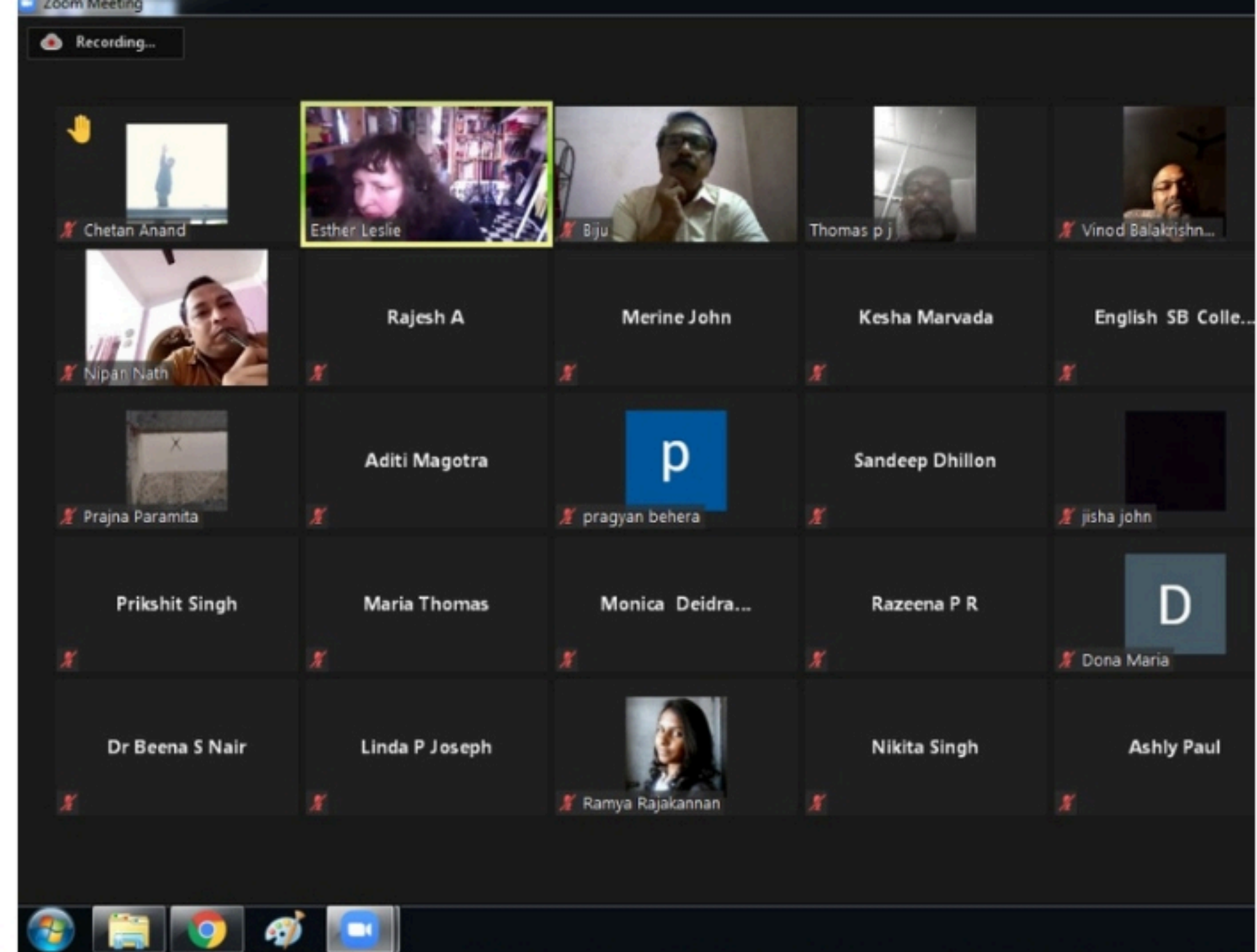

MINISTER, GOVT.OF KERALA

PROF. JOSEPH MUNDASSERY

Famous as Education Minister and Literary Critic Prof. Joseph Mundassery was a student of St. Thomas College and later on became a Professor. He was a graduate in Physics and then took Post Graduate degrees in Malayalam and Sanskrit. He was also the Head of the Department of Foreign Languages till 1952.

Joseph Mundassery brought the controversial Education Reform Bill during the 1957 Ministry of EMS Namboodiripad.

He was born in Kandassankadavu in Thrissur. He was one of the few persons behind the establishment of Kerala Sangeeta Nataka Academy and also a member of Kendra Sahitya Academy. He was also President of Kerala Sahitya Parishad. He brought in the controversial Education Reforms Bill which caused the fall of EMS Government. The Reform changed the governing of Universities, Colleges and Educational institutions. He was also the Vice Chancellor of CUSAT. Mathai Manjooran, C. Achutha Menon were some of his students.

He has written many books- Konthayil Ninnun Kurisilekku, Parappurath Vithacha Vithu, Sahityavimarsanam, Kavya Peedhika, Kumaranasante Kavitha- Oru Padanam, Vallatholinte Kavitha- Oru Padanam, Roopabhadhratha, Anthareeksham, Prayanam, Vayanasalayil, Pashchathya Sahitya Sameeksha, Mattoly, Rajarajante Mattoly. His Autobiography- Kozhinja Ilakal\*.

He passed away on 25 October, 1977.
