





Vision: Transforming Youth through Holistic Education towards an Enlightened Society

A well acclaimed academician-cum-administrator, Dr. T.N. Jayachandran I.A.S, an alumnus of St. Thomas College was the Addl. Chief Secretary of Kerala, Transport Commissioner (1994) and Vice Chancellor of University of Calicut* (1983). He was the Chairman of Cochin Port Trust in 1981 and Director of Institute of Management in 1987. Born on 22 June, 1936 to Shri. Thaivalthu Narayanan and Smt. Eswaramangalath Saradha. Dr. Jayachandran completed his Intermediate Course in St. Thomas College in 1952. He took his Honours in B.A. from University College, Trivandrum and joined Sree Kerala Varma College, Thrissur as Junior Lecturer. Later he took his I.A.S and began his administrative career as Deputy Collector. He also served as R.D.O of Devikulam. He was posted as Collector of Kottayam in 1967. Later he became the Private Secretary of the then Chief Minister of Kerala, Shri C. Achutha Menon. He underwent training in Public Administration for one year in Cambridge University, London.
