### FREEDOM FIGHTER


#### V.R. KRISHNAN EZHUTHACHAN

VR Krishnan Ezhuthachan was a famous Gandhian and well-known political leader and editor. He was the 10<sup>th</sup> son of Vadakkoot Nellipparambil Raman Ezhthachan and Peringandoor Njarassery Valappil Lakshmi Amma who were settled at Ollur, Avinisserry.

After his college studies in St Thomas College, he took Law Degree from Trivandrum Law College. He quit his Government job and entered Freedom Struggle inspired by Gandhi and also became active in Khadi-Village Industries, rural upliftment, eradication of untouchability, temple entry struggle etc. Elected to Cochin Assembly in 1954 from Orrakam and then in 1952 from Nemmara. He was the President of Thrissur District Co-operative Bank for 25 years. He was also President of Cochin Karshaka Sabha, Kerala Kisan Sabha, Thrissur District Congress President, worked as member of AICC, KPCC and also the founder General Secretary of Cochin Prajamandalam. He was the publisher of Navadeepam, Deenabandhu Gramakshemam, Karshakan etc. He had written 10 books and a few among them were Nalpathukodiyude Shabdam, Kochikku Oru Abhivrudhi Padhathi, Aatmakadha (Autobiography) etc.

He was the President of Kodannur Panchayath, Member of Prohibition Commission, Member of Coconut Development Society, Campco, State President of Bharat Karshaka Samajam, Marketing Federation, Kerala Co-operative Union, Office bearer of Warehousing Corporation, Director of KSFE, President of Fruit-Vegetable-Tapioca Societies, and also Vice President of Cochin Central Co-operative Bank etc. He took the major initiative to begin the Thrissur Co-operative Spinning Mill. He breathed his last on May 13, 2004.
