A M Thomas was a Minister in the cabinets of Jawahar Lal Nehru, Lal Bahadur Sastry and Indira Gandhi. He has also worked as the Chairman of Central Khadi Commission* for a long time. He was also elected to the Cochin Assembly and was also the Speaker in Travancore-Cochin Assembly. He was the Minister of State in Food and Agriculture Ministry and the Defence Minister in Lal Bahadur Sastry's and Indira Gandhi's Ministries. Also served as the Indian High Commissioner in Australia, Zambia and Botswana.

He passed away on April 27, 2004.
