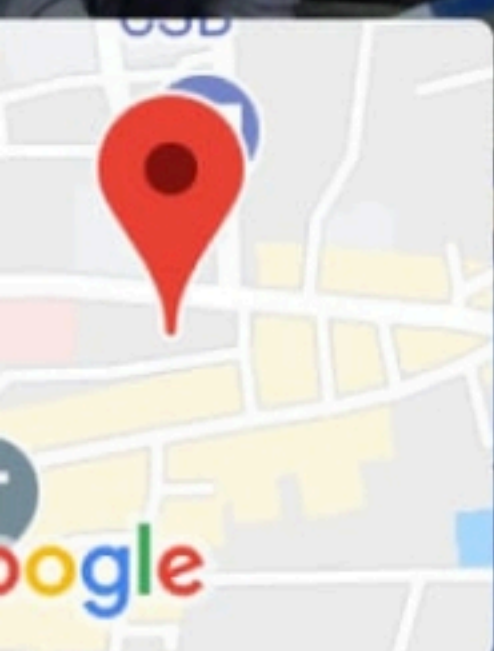
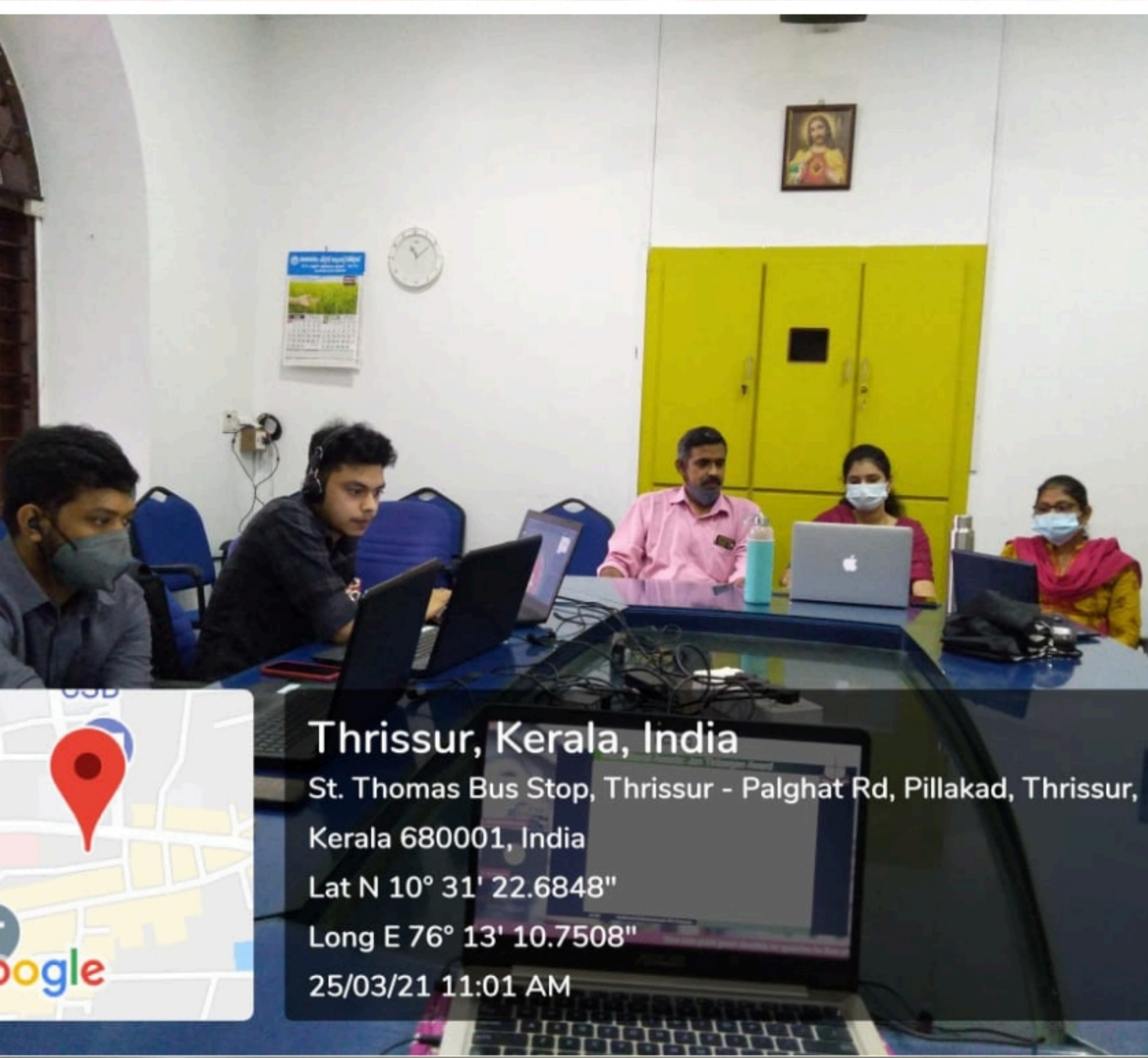

Former Vice Chancellor of Kerala University and Cochin University for Science and Technology (CUSAT)*, Dr. Jayakrishnan, an alumnus of St. Thomas College retired as Professor of Biotechnology from Indian Institute of Biotechnology, Chennai in 2018.

He had also served as Senior Scientist in Sri. Chitra Thirunaal Institute of Medical Sciences, Trivandrum. He completed his post graduation in Chemistry in University of Calicut and took his Doctorate in the same subject from the prestigious I.I.T, Chennai. After that he took is Post Doctorate from University of Florida, U.S.A. Polymeric Materials for Medical Applications was his favourite subject of study. He is the author of more than 100 erudite articles which has published in internationally acclaimed journals. Dr. Jayakrishnan has credit with several prestigious awards too. He was awarded the Fellowship of Indian academy of Science, Benguluru. Awards eamed by him also include the one for the most outstanding Alumnus of IIT, Chennai, Gold medal of Indian Science Congress (awarded by the then P.M. of India, Dr. Manmohan Singh), and Swadeshi Sastra Award (awarded by the then President of India Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam). He was also awarded the Indian National Science Academy Fellowship.
