




Well known scientist of Kerala Dr. R.S. Krishnan was the Vice Chancellor of University of Kerala.

VICE CHANCELLOR

DR. R.S. KRISHNAN

He was born at Rappal inThrissur District in 1911. He was a Fellow of Indian Academy of Science, Indian National Science Academy and London Institute of Physics. He was awarded the prestigious C.V. Raman Prize for his contribution to Physics as well as the Benguluru Indian Institute of Science Platinum Jubilee Award for Outstanding Student. Dr. C.V. Raman, Nobel Prize winner of Physics was his Research Guide. Following the retirement of Dr C.V. Raman from Indian Institute of Science, Benguluru, Dr. Krishnan became the Head of the Dept. of Physics. It was after his official retirement that he was nominated as the Vice Chancellor of University of Kerala*.
