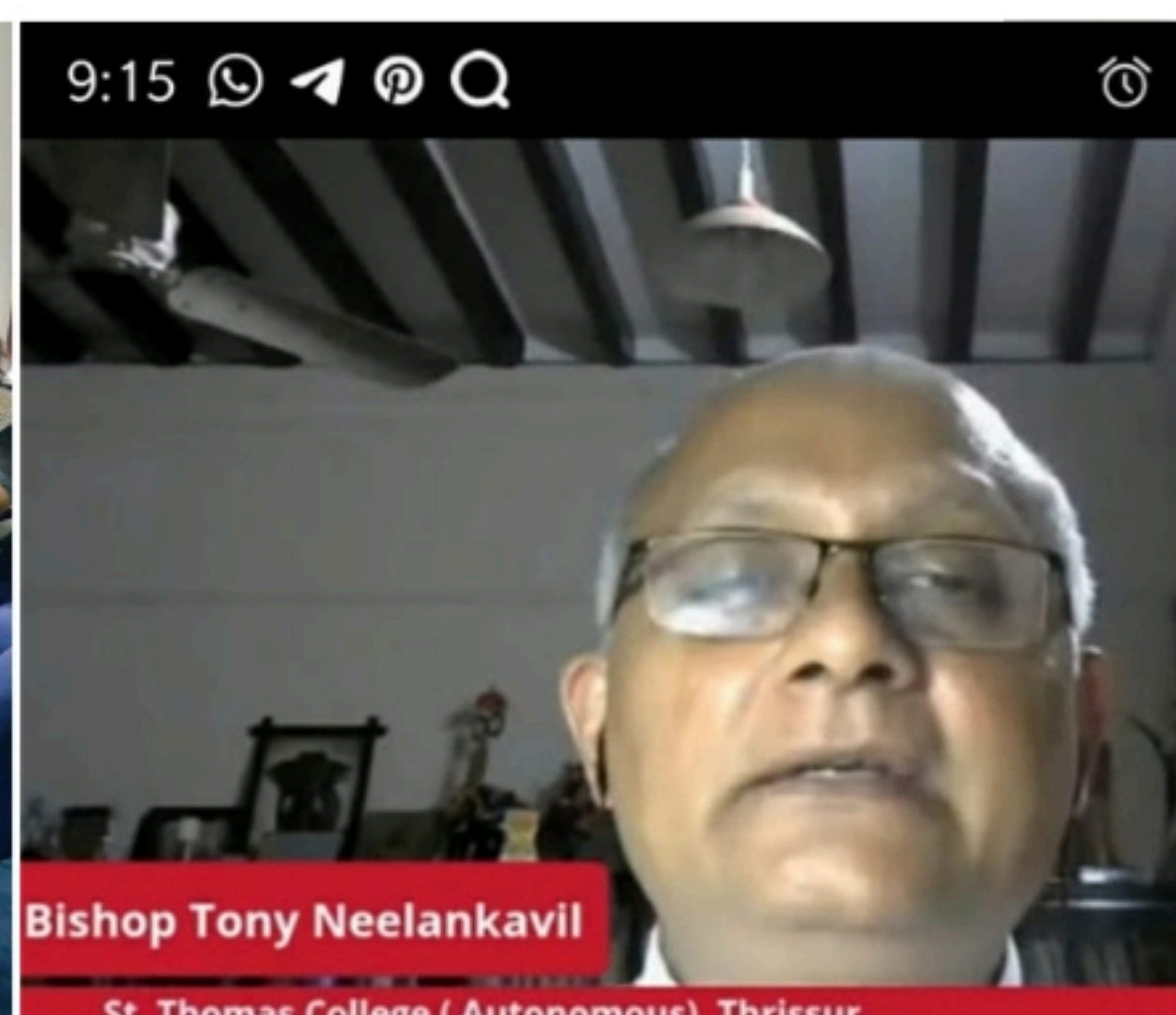
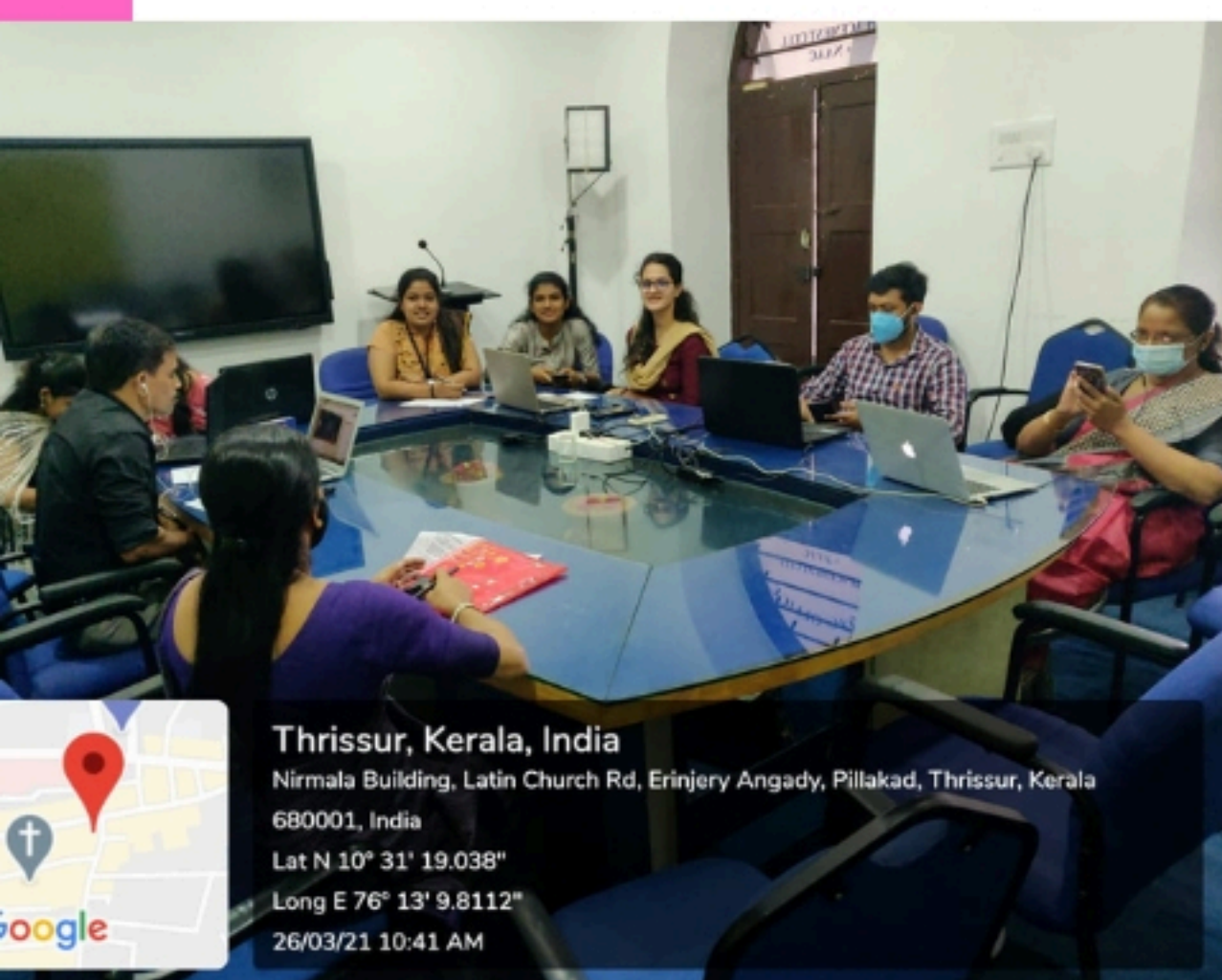

Raja Ramanna Fellowship for A. Jayakrishnan

A. Jayakrishnan, former Vice
Chancellor of the University of
Kerala and former Professor at
IIT, Madras, has been awarded
the Raja Ramanna fellowship
of the Union Department of
Atomic Energy. The fellowship
is intended to utilise the
services of active retired
scientists, engineers and
technologists who have been
involved in high quality
research in their specialised
disciplines to work at any
national laboratory or
university.

He was born at Rappal in Thrissur District in 1911. He was a Fellow of Indian Academy of Science, Indian National Science Academy and London Institute of Physics. He was awarded the prestigious C.V. Raman Prize for his contribution to Physics as well as the Bengaluru Indian Institute of Science Platinum Jubilee Award for Outstanding Student. Dr. C.V. Raman, Nobel Prize winner of Physics was his Research Guide. Following the retirement of Dr C.V. Raman from Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru, Dr. Krishnan became the Head of the Dept. of Physics. It was after his official retirement that he was nominated as the Vice Chancellor of University of Kerala*.
