NCC unit of our College organised World Malaria Day observation on 25 April 2021. A Youtube vedio was released as a part of the awareness programme for the same.





Eminent Film Critic and Writer Prof. I. Shanmughadas was a student of St Thomas College, Thrissur starting from the predegree course till the completion of his M.A. course. He had studied in the college from 1970 to 1977 and was the Editor of the College Magazine during 1974-1975.

He had taken the first group for Pre-degree, English and History Double Main for degree and English Language and Literature for Post-graduation.

Following this, he started his service as an English Professor in Government College. He had retired as the Head of the English Department of Sri. C. Achutha Menon Government College, Kuttanellur in Thrissur.

He had received the National Award for the Best Film Critic in 1999. His book on the films of Satyajit Ray, won the State award for the Best Book on cinema in 1996. In 2008, his book on Godard won the G.N Pilla Endowment Award. In 2012, he received Kerala Sahitya Academy's Vilasini Puraskaram for the Best Literary Criticism for his book 'Shareeram Nadhi Nakshathram' and the Kozhikodan Award for the Best Book on cinema for his works 'Cinemayum Chila Samvidhayakarum'. 'Daivanarthakante Krodham', his article on M.T Vasudevan Nair's 'Nirmalyam', won him the State Award for the Best Article written on films in 2013.

He is the author of 8 books. 'Malakalil Manju Peyyunnu', 'Cinemayude Vazhiyil'*, 'Sanchariyude Veedu'*, 'Aaranu Buddhanallaathathu', 'Godard: Colaykkum Marxinum Naduvil', 'P. Ramadas: Vidyarthiyude Vazhi' and 'Cinemayum Chila Samvidhayakarum' – all these are his books about cinema. 'Shareeram Nadhi Nakshathram' is a study of Arundhati Roy's renowned novel 'The God of Small Things' by him.
