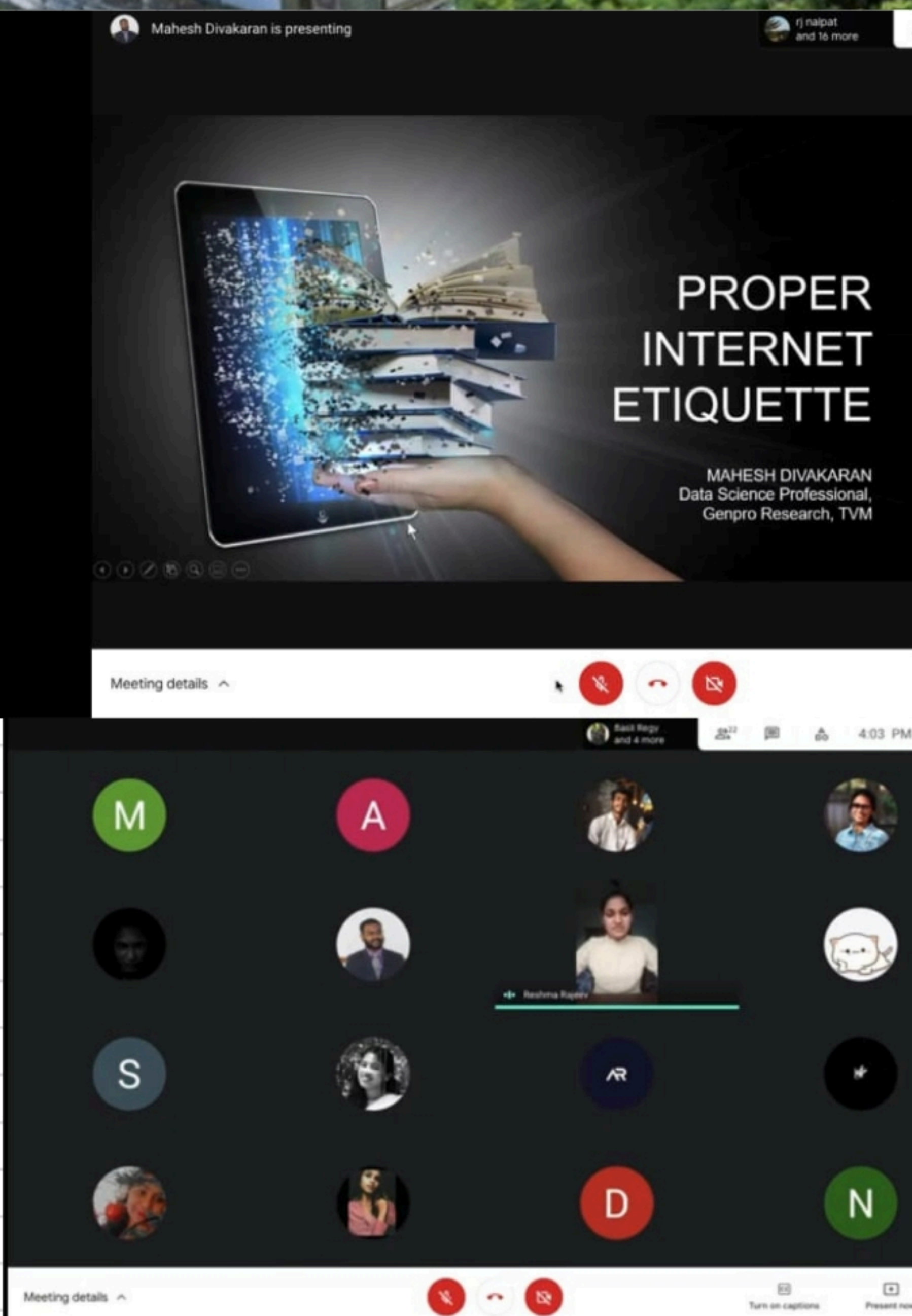

Dear madam,

With reference to the DBT Skill Vigyan programme, I am to inform you the following programmes proposed by you for submission to DBT:

- Student's training programme (2 per year)

The following criteria (as directed by DBT, Sector Skill Councils and the were considered for screening of the proposals:

Host institution should ensure the availability of existing lab facilities and manpower to conduct the programmes

Programmes proposed under Students' Training programme and Technician Training programme must be in the sectors of Agriculture, Food, Life science, Healthcare of Sector Skill Council and the course package of the Sector Skill Council should be followed.

Under the programme, financial assistance under the head consumables, food and accommodation of students, contingency is considered. No financial assistance to improve infrastructure at the host institution shall be entertained.

KBC shall recommend the following for one year: (Budget is for one programme)

Student's Training programme

Qualified and dedicated faculty members

290 hours per programme

Maximum budget – Rs. 6,92,000

Maximum participants per programme – 20

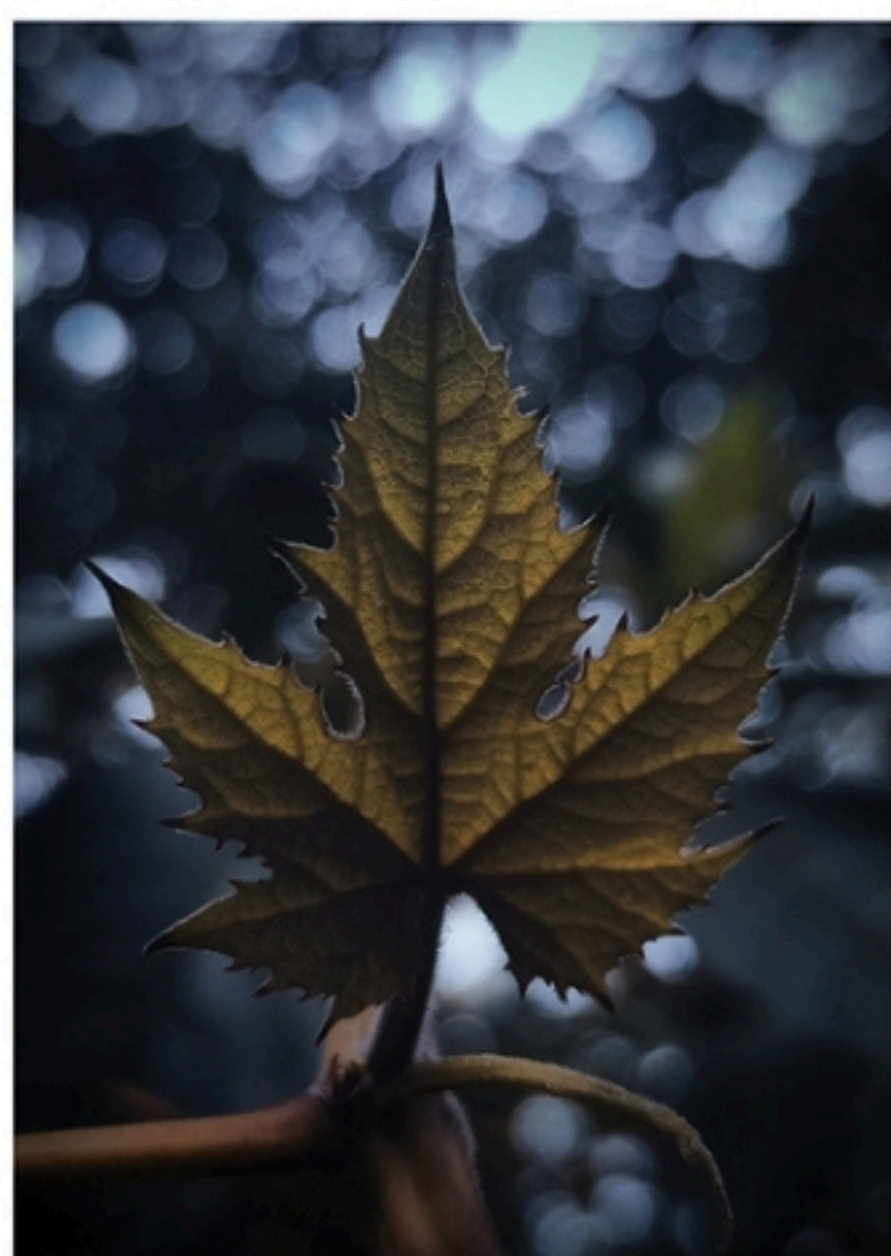
Proposed Budget per programme for 20 participants = Rs 6 92 000/-
