NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS) REGULAR WORK REPORT 2016-17

There are two units of NSS in the campus, units 42 and 144, with a total strength of 200 volunteers. The units regularly take up issues of social relevance and organises awareness activities, campaigns and conducts surveys. A summary of various activities conducted during the academic year 2016-17 is depicted below.

- 1. World environment day was observed by on June 5 by cleaning Children's park in Thrissur town.
- 2. Celebrated world blood donors day in association with IMA on June 14th and arranged a quiz competition in the college. 22 teams from different colleges participated.
- 3. 'Laharivirutha Saena' was inaugurated at St. Thomas college, Thrissur on 16th July by the state Excise Commissioner Sri. Rishiraja Sinha. The group of NSS volunteers involved in the Saena will be instrumental in campaigning against drug abuse and alcoholism in the campus.
- 4. Independence Day celebration and orientation class to new NSS volunteers in the campus was conducted on 15th August 2016.
- 5. Our volunteers participated in the 'Tiranga Yatra', a district level tricolour youth freedom march at Thrissur town, conducted as part of celebrating 70th years of Indian Independence in association with the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, Thrissur

6. Teachers Day Observed: As a mark of respect and to recognize the great effort of the Teachers, NSS volunteers of St. Thomas College, Thrissur celebrated the Teachers' Day with immense zeal and enthusiasm on 5th September 2016. The students expressed their gratitude towards their teachers by giving flowers and thanked them for being the pillars of support to them.

12. Visit to Christina orphanage, Pullazhi, Thrissur in connection with children's day November 14, 2016. The volunteers exchanged gifts, sweets and toys to the kids there and organised cultural programmes.

13.Two NSS volunteers Nijin P N and Joseph Edward Edison attended the Anti Narcotics Training Camp held at EMS Seminar complex, Calicut University on 09-11-2016.

14. The NSS programme officers Dr. Paulson Mathew participated in the Inaugural function of Quami Ektha celebrations on 13-11-2016 at

Cheraman Juma Masjid, Kodungallur.

15. World Aids Day was observed on December 1st 2016. Banner and posters were displayed in the college as well as in streets (college road). Awareness class was conducted. In association with Thrissur Medical Association, a magic show was conducted in the college high lighting the importance of aids awareness, prevention and AIDS control measures.

16. Sent Student secretaries for one day training programme at KAU on 7th

December 2016.

23.Inauguration of State Level Janakeyasuthranam, 2nd phase at Thrissur on 21st January 2017 by the Hon'ble Chief minister of Kerala Sri Pinarayi Vijayan at Thrissur. 35 NSS volunteers from St. Thomas College participated in the programme. 24. Digital Economy: Inauguration of "Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan" (VISAKA), a programme of promoting cashless transactions by the Govt.
