#### Concept Note

How might we re-engage (or dis-engage) the language debate, especially pertaining to the career of English in India from the vantage point of the present? The task would necessarily involve a reappraisal of the radical historical, political and pedagogic shifts that have happened in the last few decades. The talk will critically look at the history of English language and literature in India and the various ideological tasks it performed.

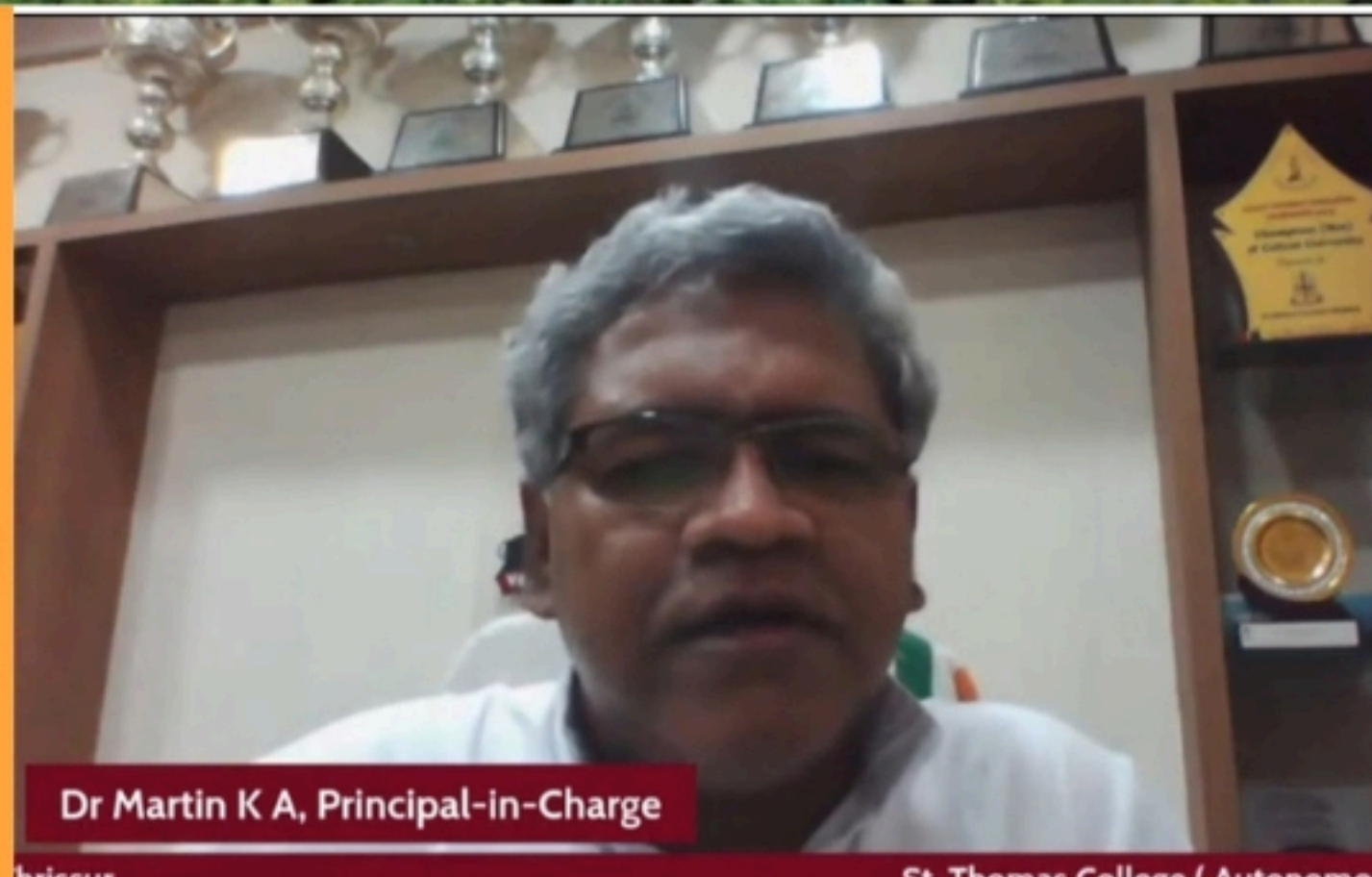
We will look at the complex ways in which English both as a language of communication and social power and as a site of disciplinary practice contributed to the shaping of a postcolonial modernity underpinned by various forms of aspirations and aversions.

Drawing on some of the contemporary debates about the role of English education, the talk will try to have a closer look at the relationship between the Indian vernaculars and English, and speculate on a different trajectory of historicizing the language question vis-à-vis the formation of modern linguistic identities.
