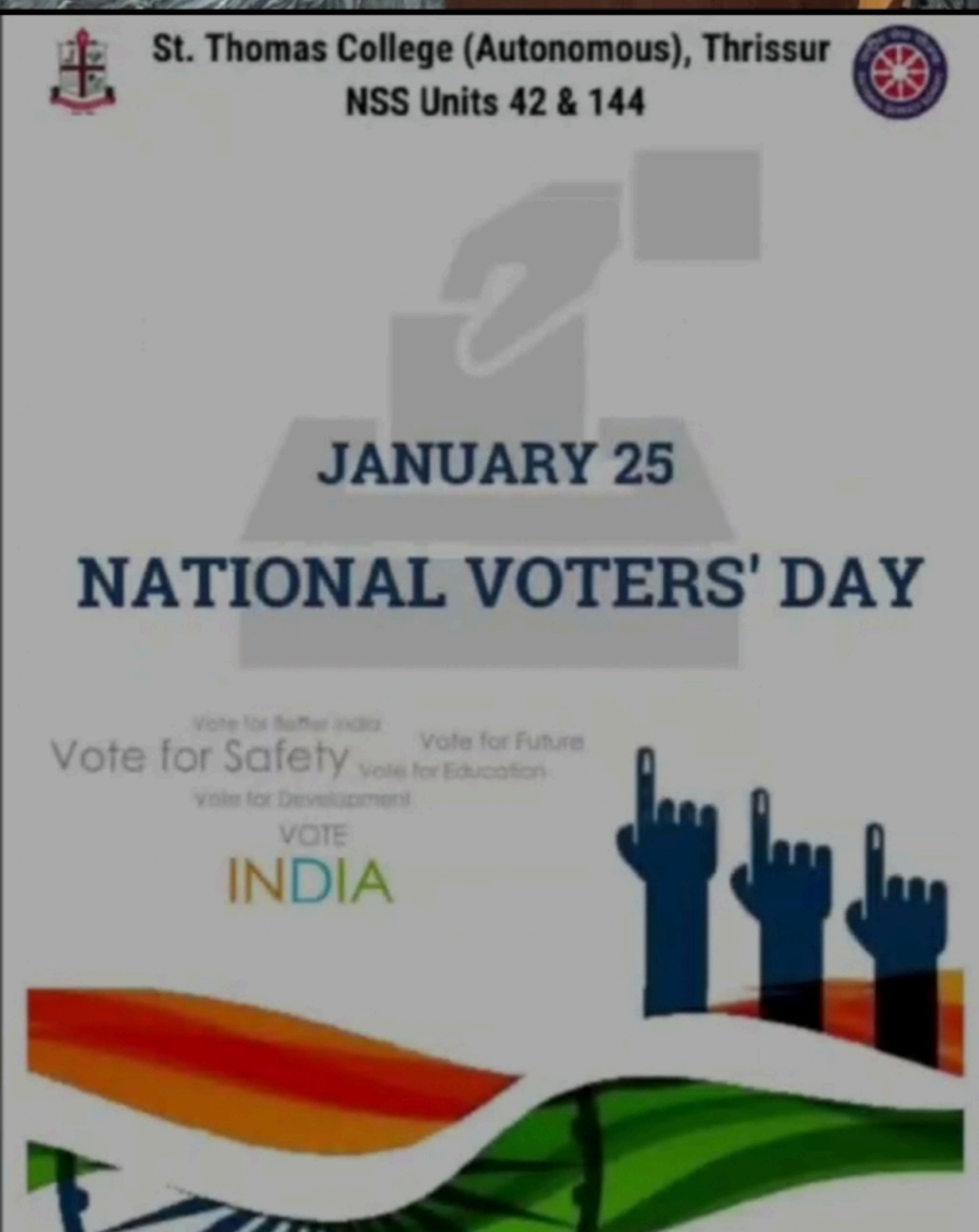
Vision: Transforming the Youth through Holistic Education towards an Enlightened Society

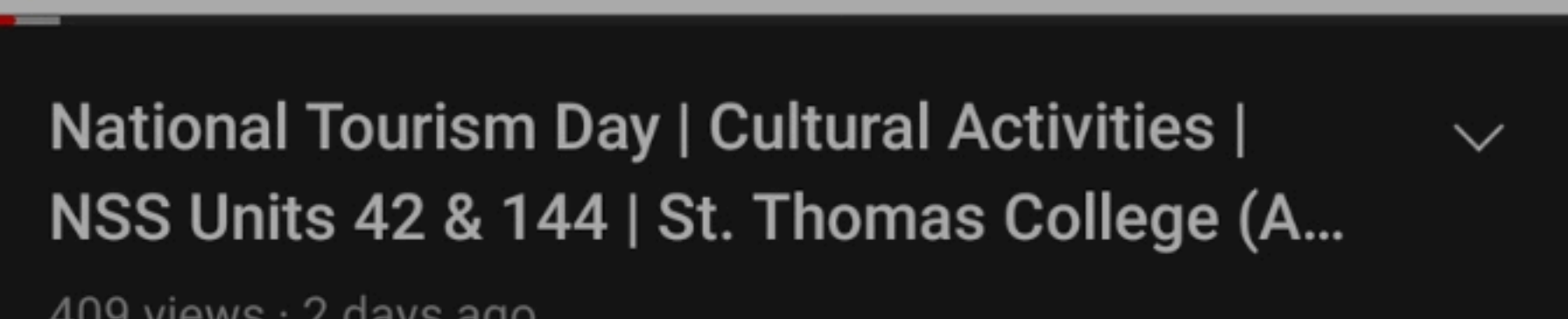
NSS unit of the College organised National Voters Day celebrations on 25 January 2022. Voter's Day pledge was taken by the NSS volunteers online.
