For the academic year 2017-2018, the feedback about the syllabus was collected from the stakeholders. All these feedbacks were collected by using a five-point rating scale and analysed using R Programming software.

TEACHER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM

The faculty feedback form consisted of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level with the syllabus. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the faculty feedback for the academic year 2017-2018.


- The syllabus is suitable for the programme in the opinion of 68% of the faculty.
- The syllabus is need-based, in the opinion of 63% of the faculty.
- Around 58% of them will agree that the aims and objectives of the syllabi are well-defined and clear to teachers and students.
- Comparatively, most of the faculties (58%) agree that a sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the library.
- There is an agreement (46%) to the fact that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application.
- The programme/syllabus of this subject increased 70% of the faculties' knowledge in the subject area.
- 83% of the faculties well agree that tests and examinations are conducted well in advance of time.
- All units in the syllabus are sufficiently well completed before the examinations, which has been agreed upon by 79% of the faculties.
- Only 35% of the faculties have the freedom to propose, modify, suggest and incorporate new topics in the syllabus.
- There is an agreement (33%) to the statement that more time may be availed to complete the syllabus by conducting examinations in the first week of April.
- 78% of the faculties have the freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching such as seminar presentations, group discussions, and learners' participation.
- 47% of the faculties have the freedom to adopt new techniques of evaluation and assessment of students.
- The environment in the department is conducive to more than 59% of the faculties for teaching and research.
- There is an agreement (69%) to the statement that the administration is teacher-friendly.
- Around 62% of the faculties agree that the college provides adequate and smooth support for projects and research facilities.

Provisions for professional development are non-discriminatory and fair and are agreed upon by 58% of the faculties.
