
- The syllabus is need-based, updated, and has a good balance between theory and application in the opinion of 86% of the faculties.
- Around 92% of the faculties agree well that the syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area.
- The assessment and evaluation system objectively measures the Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and is agreed by 87% of the faculty.
- 87% of the faculties agree very well that the college has enough relevant resources which are updated regularly for teaching-learning purposes.






