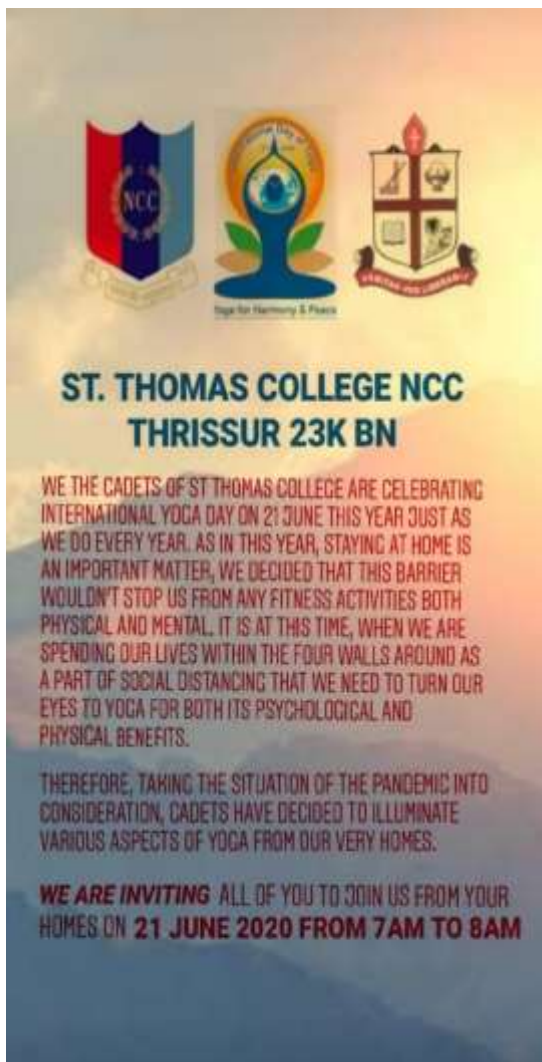

Date: - 10 February- 14 February 2021



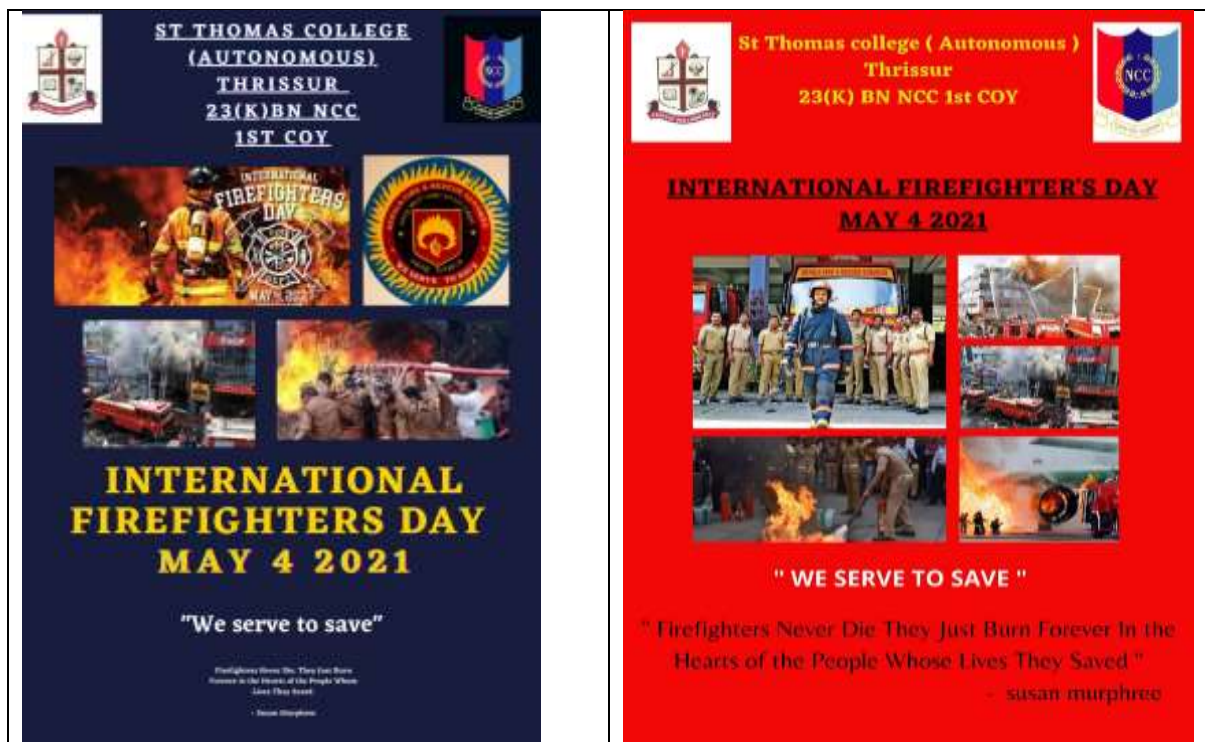

Date: - 4 May 2021

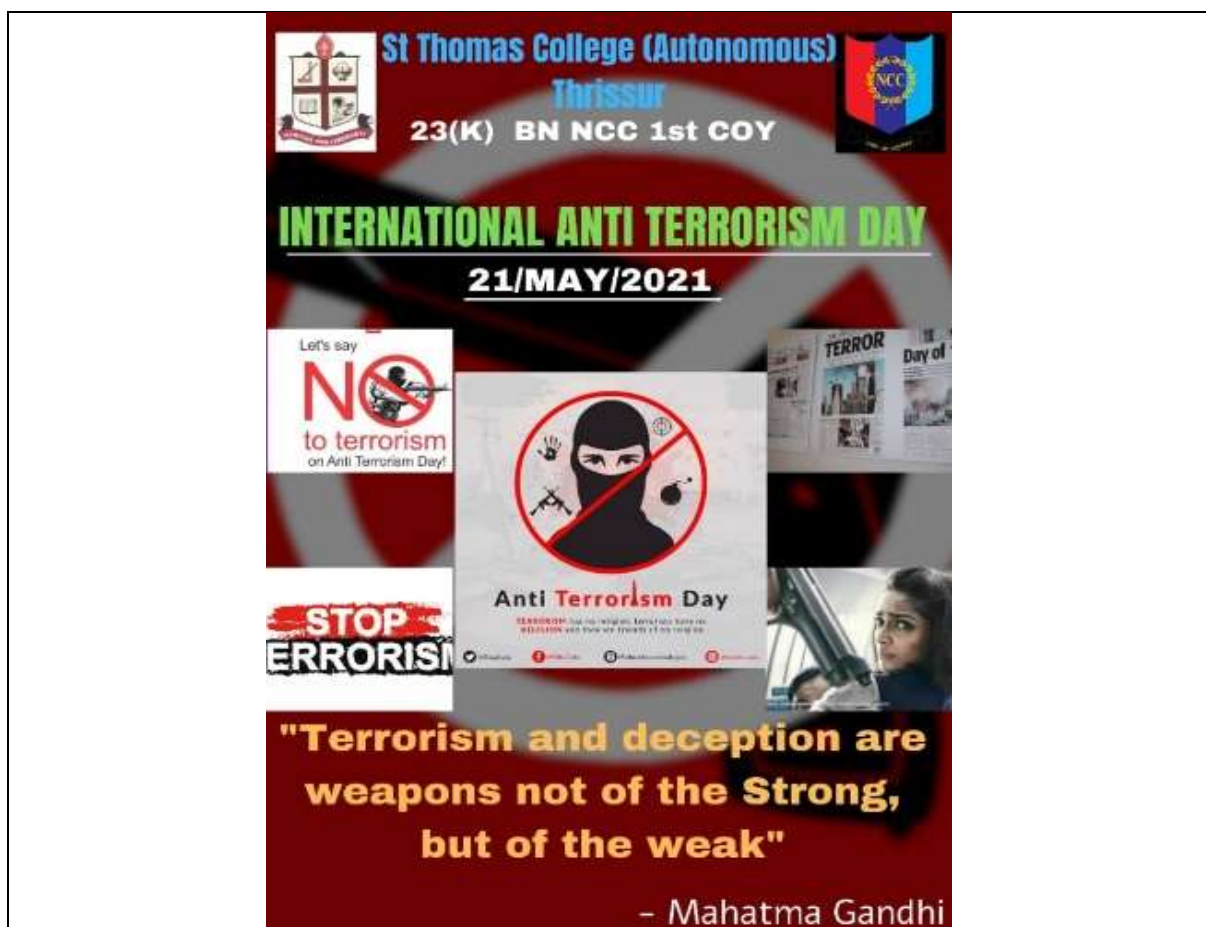

Date: - 21 May 2021

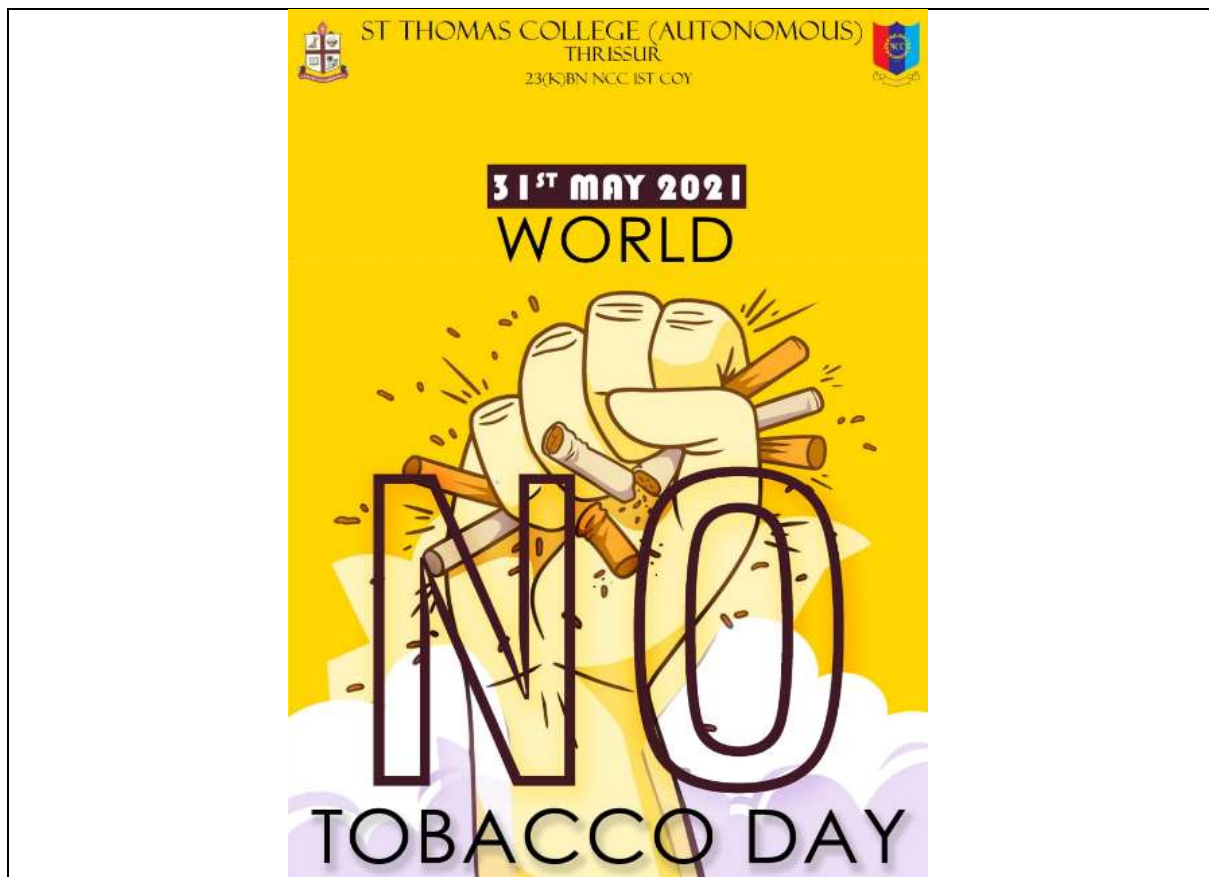
