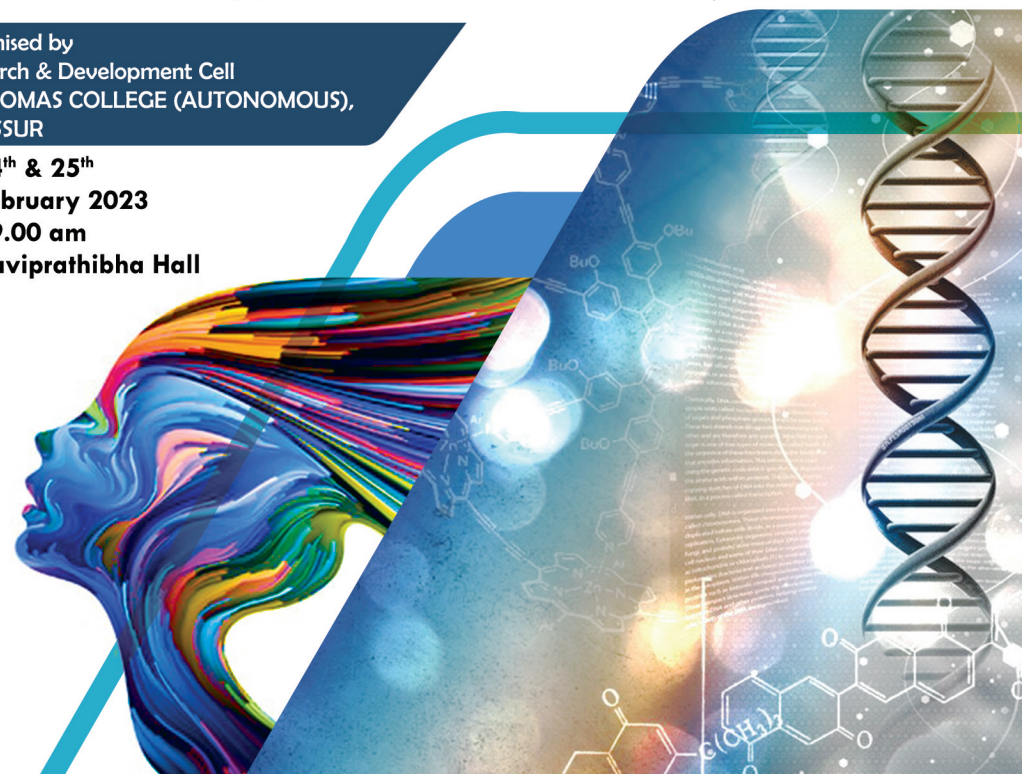

St. Thomas College (Autonomously), Thrissur is an oldest Catholic College in Kerala founded as an educational institution in 1889 by the Vicar Apostolic of Thrissur, Rt. Rev. Dr. Adolphus Edwin Medlycott, a former Professor of Rhetoric at the Propaganda College, Rome. It is the first college to have been established by diocesan clergy in India, older than all the Universities in Kerala, and was raised to the rank of a Second Grade College in 1919.
