For the academic year 2022-2023, the feedback about the syllabus was collected from the stakeholders. All these feedbacks were collected by using a five-point rating scale and analysed using R Programming software.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM

The students feedback form consists of questions that truly indicated their satisfaction level about syllabus. Given below are the conclusions obtained by analyzing the students feedback for the academic year 2022 - 2023.

- The curriculum prepared and motivated 85 % of them to pursue higher education / research.
- Around 80 % of the students agreed to the statement that the curriculum covers recent trends and developments.
- Assignments/ Seminars/ Projects in curriculum helps 90 % of students to attain the course outcomes.
- Around 70 % of the students agreed that there is sufficient space for internship / field visits / projects in the curriculum.
- 90 % of the students agreed that the library facilities including online databases is relevant in terms of their usefulness.
- The current curriculum is makes 70 % of them competent to the external job market and to meet the societal needs.
- The curriculum is helpful for 80% of the students in developing human values.
- Reference books mentioned in the syllabus are relevant, useful for 80 % students
- Most of the students (80%) agreed to the statement that the topics having local and regional relevance are available in the syllabus.
- Curriculum focus on gender sensitization and related issues, including dedicated courses in Languages, Gender Studies, and Voices of Women is agreed by 72 % of them.
