


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ST THOMAS COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS), THRISSUR MIZHIVU 2024 – '25

Programme Guidelines:

- A student can participate in four individual on-stage events and three group on-stage events. This limitation will not confer in the case of offstage events
- For group events there must be only **one team** from each department
- Participants shall be awarded points on the following basis

	Individual	Group
First	5	10
Second	3	6
Third	1 ARTS	2

- Participant securing the maximum points in individual events shall be awarded the titles of Kalathilakam (Female) and Kalaprathibha (Male)
- The participants must wear their college IDs during the days of Fine Arts
- The participants should carefully study the rules (both general and item specific) before the competitions. The decisions of the judges are final and binding on all situations
- In the case of any disciplinary issues and violation of rules, the Fine Arts Appeal committee has the authority to disqualify the individual participants and groups.
- For appealing a result, an amount of Rs **500**/- should be remitted with the concerned appeal request (available in the website) within one hour from the announcement of result, duly authorised by the Team manager
- The event shall be conducted only if the there is at least two participants for the event
- Students can register for the events through the college website (<u>https://stthomas.ac.in/arts2024</u>) from 06.12.2024 to 09.12.2024 for off stage and from 06.12.2024 to 13.12.2024 for on stage.

• For Literary items subjects will be announced only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.

• The paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.

• The participants should bring other articles like pen, ink, brush, paint etc.

3. Versification- English, Malayalam, Hindi, Arabic, Sanskrit, Urdu and Tamil

• For Literary items subjects will be announced only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.

• The paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.

• The participants should bring other articles like pen, ink, brush, paint etc.

4. Extempore- English, Malayalam, Hindi, Arabic, Sanskrit, Urdu and Tamil

• Duration: 5 minutes.

• Topic will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.

5. Quiz

• Quiz is conducted as an individual event

• For quiz the specific rules regarding evaluation procedure, time to reply a particular

answer and the type of round will be given before the actual start of the competition.

• The decision of the Quizmaster will be final and binding on the participants

6. Debate

• Duration: 5 minutes

Medium of language: English/ Hindi/Malayalam

• Each department shall have only **one** team of which one member should favour the topic and the other must speak against it

- Topic will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition

- Theme will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.
- Paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.

- Theme will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.
- Paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.
- Participants should bring the necessary articles.
- Duration will not be more than 3 hours.

11. Cartoon Drawing

• Theme and other specific rules will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement

of the competition.

- Paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.
- · Participants should bring the necessary articles
- Duration will not be more than 1 hour.

12. Pencil Drawing

- Theme will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.
- Paper required will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.
- Participants should bring the necessary articles
- Duration will not be more than 1 hour.

13. Clay Modelling

- Topic /size will be given only 5 minutes before the commencement of the competition.
- Duration will not be more than 3 hours.
- Clay will be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.

• No reference will be allowed.

14. Collage

- Paper required will **not** be supplied by the Fine Arts Committee.(only white sheet will be provided)
- Collage will be conducted on the spot.
- Participants are requested to bring their own scissors and other materials required

15. Embroidery

- Cloth will not be provided by Fine Arts Committee.
- The participants should bring their own embroidery thread and needle etc.

16. Poster Making

- Item will be conducted on the spot on the given topic/subject.
- Duration will not be more than 2hours.
- Topics/size and other specific rules shall be announced on the spot

17. Rangoli

- Duration will not be more than 2 hours
- Participants shall bring their own material.
- Only one medium shall be used Rangoli Colours
- The participants shall have to prepare a rangoli within the space provided by the Organizers
- No reference will be allowed.

18. Spot Photography

• The participants have to bring his/her own digital camera.

- The time limit will be 2 hours.
- The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the

judges.

• No mixing, matching or morphing of photographs will be permitted. Software such as Photoshop etc. for enhancing images not permitted. The organizers will have all rights for the use of these pictures as and when they deem fit. Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (i) Impact, (ii) Composition, (iii) Technical quality, (iv) suitability of the specific theme.

• The additional instructions will be announced on the spot

19. Pookkalam

• Only flowers shall be used, **leaves, twigs, powders** etc. are **not allowed**. Participants are allowed to to prepare flowers before the competition

• The pookkalam may be both figurative and abstract.

- Duration should be not more than 2 hours.
- Diameter of the Pookkalam will be 1 meter

- The accompanists need not be participants.
- Time limit is 5 minutes.

21. Classical Music (M/F)

- 2 accompanists(students) are allowed.
- The accompanists need not be participants.

- Instruments to be played by the participants only.
- Duration: 10 minutes.
- Participants : 6+3

23. Group Song (Western)

• Instruments to be played by the participants only.

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- Duration: 10 minutes.
- Participants : 6+3

24. Mappilappattu (Group)

- Participants : 6
- Duration: 10 minutes.

25. Mappilappattu (M&F)

• Duration: 5 minutes.

26. Vocal-Western (Individual)

- Maximum time for stage/instruments setting is 5 minutes.
- The number of accompanists would not be more than two.
- Duration of song shall be between 4 to 6 minutes.
- Language of the song shall be English only.

• Judgement will be based on the qualities like composition of rhythm, co-ordination and general impression.

27. Vocal-Folk (Group)

- The group can consist of all boys or girls or combined.
- Duration of the performance will be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 minutes;

this does not include setting time which shall not be more than 5 minutes.

• Maximum three accompanists are allowed who should be in different dress from the

student participants so that they could be easily identified.

- They shall sit/stand separately from the participants and shall not lead the team.
- The team may present preferably those folk tunes which are recognized as folk tune.

28. Semi Classical

- Cinema songs are **not** allowed.
- Item can be presented either in Hindustani or in Carnatic style.
- Time 8-10 minutes

54. Thiruvathirakali (F)

- Participants : 8+2
- Duration: 10 minutes.
- For various dance items non students shall be allowed to provide background music

(both vocal & Instrumental).

- This is the traditional form of Thiruvathirakali and not any other form of Kaikottikali.
- Only lady students shall be allowed to participate in this item.

55. Kolkali (M)

- This is the traditional folk art Kolkali and not Kolattam.
- Participants: 12
- Duration: 10 minutes.

56. Duffmutt (M)

- Participants: 10
- Duration: 10 minutes.

57. Oppana (F)

62. Keralanatanam

- Participants: 1
- 3 accompanists are allowed.
- Duration: 15 minutes.

• For various dance items non students shall be allowed to provide background music

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(both vocal & Instrumental).

63. Drama

• The time allotted for staging the drama i.e., 30 minutes, includes the time for stage setting between the scenes.

• In addition, not more than 10 minutes will be allowed for setting the stage before the commencement of the drama.

• Participants: 8

• Non students are allowed to provide background music.

64. Mime

• Mime is a group item. There shall be a maximum of 6 participants

• The presentation of the act or idea shall be only gestures and body movements, without words.

• Qualities like idea, creativity of presentation, use of makeup, music and general

impression shall be the criterion of judgment.

• Duration: 5 minutes.

65. Skit- English/ Malayalam

• For item Skit, use of makeup, drapery and background music is allowed.

• No personal remarks, aspersions, character assassination etc is allowed.

• Participating team should submit **three** copies of the synopsis of the same skit, along and general impression.

• Vulgarity or bitter insinuations in presentation should be avoided. Only innocent satire

or humour is expected.

- Duration: 8 to 10 minutes.

66. Kathaprasangam

- Participants: 1+3
- Duration: 15 minutes.

• For Kathaprasangam the background music will be limited to instrumental item and the

vocal music should be by the participants themselves.
